Subject: Weekly Update

PUBLIC WORKS

Operational Updates:

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 44.219 MG this reporting period, June 13 19, 2022, up from 41.431 MG the previous week. The daily peak water demand occurred when 6.613 MG was used on Monday, June 13. There were 0.0 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- There was an estimated water loss of 140,000 gallons, four hydrants were flushed, and forty-seven valves were exercised.
- There was one service line repaired.
- Crews responded to five sewer calls, and one sewer line was repaired.
- Twenty-one hundred feet of sewer line was televised, and 14,200 feet of sewer line was cleaned in the Lakeside Park area.
- Over ten right-of-way locates were completed.
- The Solid Waste Division received five calls with scheduling questions and six complaints (four trash, one bulk, and one brush).
- Eight recycle bins were distributed to residents.

Street Division

- Installed two ADA ramps at 203-303 Merribrook Tr.
- Marked 23 right-of-way locates.
- Inspected 189 inlets and cleaned 28.
- Removed 9.75 cubic yards of trash and debris from inlets.
- Cleaned and flushed drainage pipe at 527 Roundtop and 1119-1123 Jungle.
- Filled pothole at 600 W. Center.
- Removed tree blocking the street at 242 Larry.
- Removed tree blocking the street at 1314 Hill City.
- Provided traffic control for Duncan Switch.

CIP Construction

• E. Danieldale Road Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main Street to US-67) – The project has entered Phase 3, which entails the remaining water, sewer, and drainage utilities, eastbound lane pavement, the 8-foot trail, landscaping, and a City of Duncanville monument. The City's contractor, Pavecon, moved all traffic to the new westbound lanes and is starting to remove the existing eastbound lane concrete. Their subcontractor, M-CO, is working on the 18-inch water main. Other subcontractors are continuing to work on finishing the sod and 12-foot trail on the north side of the road.



Forest Hills Ramps Reconstruction – The City of Duncanville and the Dallas County Planning & Development Department, via the federally funded HUD / Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, are reconstructing and improving the reinforced concrete ramps and sidewalks at four intersections within the Forest Hills Subdivision. The City's contractor, Northstar Construction, LLC, began clearing and grubbing vegetation, removing concrete where ramps will be installed, and setting the concrete formwork at the Forest-Alexander intersection. Northstar has also poured the majority of the concrete ramps and sidewalk at the Center-Forest intersection.





The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project - Green Ribbon Project construction commenced on October 11, 2021, with estimated completion now scheduled to occur in June of 2022. In addition to site and irrigation improvements, the contractor is installing piers for the Wintergreen Road monument and pouring concrete for the footings. Landscape planting is expected to occur in July.




• Fire Station #1 – Staff and BRW Architects completed the 100% Construction Drawings. CORE Construction, the Construction Manager at Risk, put the project out for bid. A "Subcontractor Outreach Event" was conducted on March 22, 2022, at the Senior Center from 4:00 pm-6:00 pm, and a Virtual Pre-bid meeting was held on March 24, 2022. CORE opened bids on April 7, 2022. Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement in June 2022. Construction commencement should occur in Summer or Fall of this year, with completion anticipated in the Summer of 2023.




Other Construction

ONCOR Transmission Line Work @ W. Camp Wisdom Rd & N. Cedar Ridge.
On July 29, 2021, staff met with ONCOR to discuss the upcoming project to replace
transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. The ONCOR contractor finished
transferring the cables to the new towers along Camp Wisdom Rd and N. Cedar
Ridge Drive and removed the existing towers. They will be removing the tower
foundations in the coming weeks.



• TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd to Hampton Rd – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd in Duncanville to Hampton Rd in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT plans to relocate Cockrell Hill Rd Texas U-Turn from the northeast side of the bridge (not desired) to the southwest side of the bridge (desired). The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction meeting with TXDOT and the Contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of November 2024.

• ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District – ONCOR is planning electrical line upgrades along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades intend to improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work is expected to start in Summer of 2022.



DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Economic Development

- Continued collaboration with City departments on a grant for water infrastructure.
- ARPA applications have been thoroughly reviewed and verified. Approved applicants will be brought before City Council for review and approval June 27.
- DCEDC Board Meeting June 22, 2022:
 - Revised Incentive Policy was approved by the DCEDC Board. Policy will be brought before City Council for approval at the next available meeting.
 - Incentive Application for the business located at 1114 S. Main Street, doing business as Red Bird Lanes, was approved for a paint grant totaling \$5,000 and an architectural improvement grant to replace the rear fence in the amount of \$6,683.60. A development agreement will be drafted, and the agreement and application will be brought before City Council for approval at the next available meeting.

Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 192 inspections (including reinspections) and currently have a total of 106 open cases.
- The Health Inspector conducted 28 health inspections.

Building Inspections

- A total of 1,796 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; two
 new properties were registered since the last update. Sixty-seven inspections were
 completed since the previous update. Twenty-six passed, thirty-five failed, and six
 were canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of
 GFCI protection, and missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of
 1008 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the SingleFamily Rental Registration Program.
- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$377,944.17 has been collected. A total of \$5,924.90 has been collected since January 1, 2022. \$1,248.23 was collected this week.
- This week 107 permits were issued, and 194 inspections were done. to date we
 have inspected 5 mobile vending units. 1 mobile vending was inspected this week.

- Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.

Short-Term Rental Registration Program

- Twenty notification letters were mailed out to property owners on April 1.
- One owner did not receive an initial notice but did respond.
- Thirteen property responded to the initial notices.
- Six properties are currently going through the Specific Use Permit (SUP) process.
- Seven properties are no longer operating as short-term rentals.
- Eight property owners have not responded.
- Final notices are expected to be mailed out next month.

FISCAL SERVICES

Utility Customer Service Office

- On June 21, 2022, the UCSO department processed disconnections for Cycle 2 customers with a past due balance. Approximately 151 disconnections were processed.
- UCSO also received meter curb stops from the Core and Main company, which allowed us to replace four customer curb stops. We will continue to replace curb stops as we receive them from Core and Main.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 131 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - o 98 EMS calls
 - Six motor vehicle accidents
 - One building fire in Lancaster
 - One grass fire in Duncanville
 - One dumpster fire in Duncanville
- The Department has no vacancies. Of our four new employees, two of the firefighters now count as staffing. Two others will not be counted as staffing until they complete the required training and attend a firefighter academy. Two new employees are paramedics certified with the Texas Department of Health Services and will be attending DeSoto's fire academy. The other two new employees are fire certified with the Texas Commission on Fire Protection and will be attending paramedic school.
- The Fire Department has completed all promotional exams except the Driver/ Engineer position. The Civil Service Driver/Engineer promotional exam was administered on Wednesday, June 15, 2022. Two firefighters passed the exam. We are awaiting the appeal process to receive the final Civil Service Driver/Engineer list.
- The National Weather Service has issued a Heat Advisory until Friday, June 24, at 7:00 p.m. Hot temperatures and high humidity will increase the risk for heatrelated illnesses. Drink plenty of fluids and stay in an air-conditioned building if possible.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

PERSONNEL

- Officer Fares Acosta is currently in his second phase of field training and is doing well.
- Officer Ralston Marshall is currently in his third phase of field training. His expected completion of field training is June 29.
- Cadet Jessica Determan began employment with the department on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, and will begin the basic peace officer academy next Monday, June 27, at the North Central Texas Council of Government.
- We have seven openings.
- Training and Personnel Division are currently working backgrounds of the police applicants.
- Recruits Saul Vara and Brandon Dunn are doing very well at the Dallas County Sheriff's Office Police Academy. They are both scheduled to graduate at the end of July.
 - The recruits are in their second week of firearms training, and this week they conducted their nighttime qualification. They were also familiarized on the 870 shotgun and patrol rifle.




Top Content – Facebook (Based on reach)
