Operational Updates:

Director Updates on Council Requests

6/28/2022	Councilmember Contreras	Status of Traffic Improvements at Oriole and I20 Frontage Rd	The State of Texas owns I20 Frontage Rd, and the City must partner with TxDOT in making traffic improvements at Oriole and I20 Frontage Rd. TxDOT has begun the review process and requests an additional two weeks to complete its review before making final recommendations.

Street Division

- Closed access to the bridge at 1100 Briar Hill Circle. A bridge inspection and pavement repair are required to reopen it. Structural engineers found no structural damage at this bridge. Streets will repair pavement with asphalt level-up next week.
- Marked twenty right-of-way locates.
- Inspected 113 inlets, cleaned twelve, and removed four cubic yards of trash and debris.
- Inspected nine headwalls. All nine were cleaned and four cubic yards of brush and other debris were removed.
- Cleaned bar ditch at 100 W. Red Bird.
- Repaired streets at 203-303 Merribrook and 215 Linda.



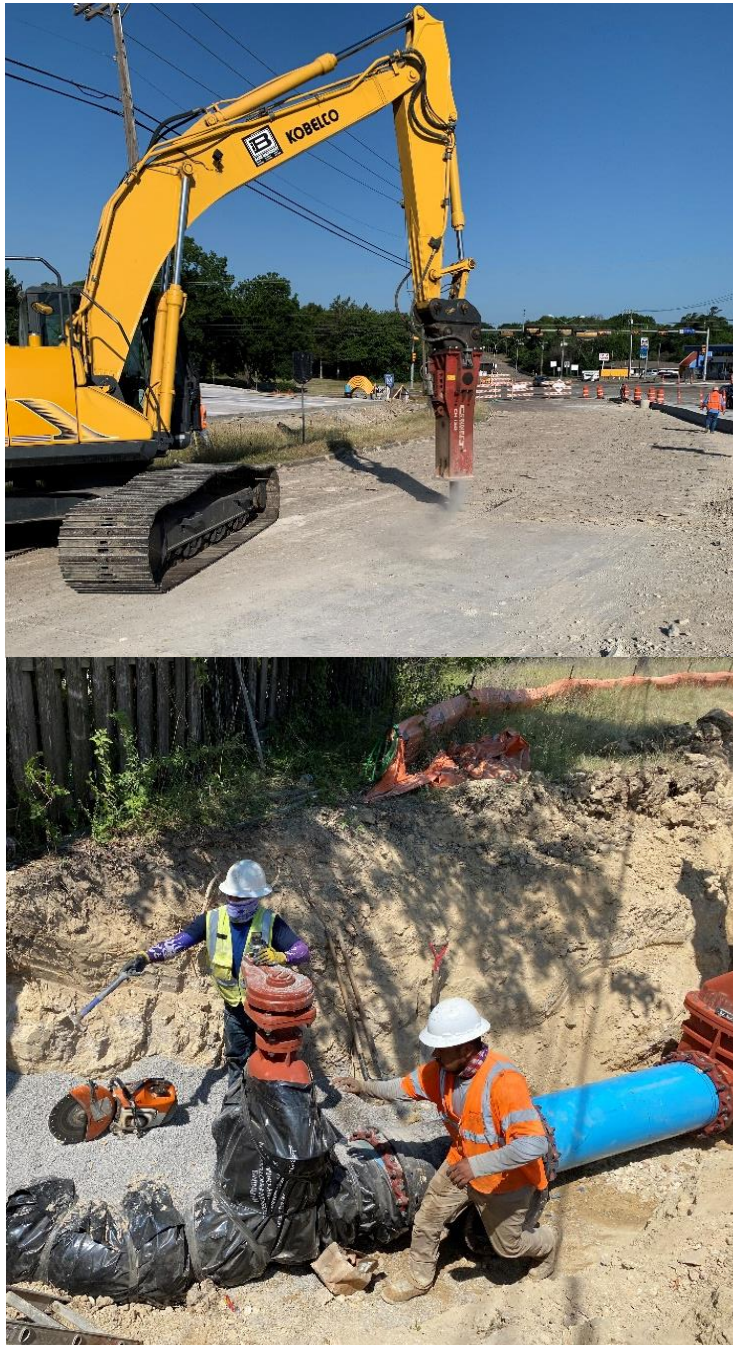

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 50.163 MG this reporting period, June 20-26, 2022, up from 44.219 MG the previous week. The daily peak water demand occurred on Friday, June 24, when 7.768 MG was used. There were 0.0 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- There was an estimated water loss of 315,000 gallons, and nine hydrants were flushed.
- One hydrant was repaired and one was replaced.
- Crews responded to six sewer calls, one sewer dig, and one sprinkler repair.
- Eighty feet of sewer line was televised.
- Over fifteen right-of-way locates were completed.
- The Solid Waste Division received three calls with scheduling questions and fourteen complaints: two trash, five bulk, six brush, and one recycle.
- Seven recycle bins were distributed.

CIP Construction

- **E. Danieldale Rd Reconstruction & Utility Improvements Project (Main St to US-67)** – The City’s contractor, Pavecon, is removing the existing eastbound concrete beginning at S. Main St. Their subcontractor, M-CO, is working on the 18-inch water main. Other subcontractors continue to work on finishing the sod and 12-foot trail on the north side of the road.

- Forest Hills Ramps Reconstruction** – The City of Duncanville and the Dallas County Planning & Development Department, via the federally funded HUD Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, are reconstructing and improving the reinforced concrete ramps and sidewalks at four intersections in the Forest Hills Subdivision. The City’s contractor, Northstar Construction, LLC, continued clearing and grubbing vegetation, removing concrete where ramps will be installed, and setting the concrete formwork at the Forest – Alexander intersection, as well as the Alexander Ave. – Alexander Ct. intersection. The concrete ramps and sidewalks at the Center-Forest intersection have been installed.



- **The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project** - Green Ribbon Project construction commenced on October 11, 2021, with estimated completion now scheduled to occur in July of 2022. In addition to site and irrigation improvements, the contractor is installing piers for the Wintergreen Road monument and pouring concrete for the footings. Landscape planting is expected to occur in July.



- **Fire Station #1** – Staff and BRW Architects completed the 100% Construction Drawings. CORE Construction, the Construction Manager at Risk, put the project out for bid. A “Subcontractor Outreach Event” was conducted on March 22, 2022, at the Senior Center from 4:00 pm-6:00 pm, and a Virtual Pre-bid meeting was held on March 24, 2022. CORE opened bids on April 7, 2022. Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement in June 2022. Construction commencement should occur in Summer or Fall of this year, with completion anticipated in the Summer of 2023.



Other Construction

- **ONCOR Transmission Line Work @ W. Camp Wisdom Rd & N. Cedar Ridge.** On July 29, 2021, staff met with ONCOR to discuss the upcoming project to replace transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. The ONCOR contractor finished transferring the cables to the new towers along Camp Wisdom Rd and N. Cedar Ridge Drive and removed the existing towers. They will be removing the tower foundations in the coming weeks.



- **TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd to Hampton Rd** – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd in Duncanville to Hampton Rd in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT plans to relocate Cockrell Hill Rd Texas U-Turn from the northeast side of the bridge (not desired) to the southwest side of the bridge (desired). The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction meeting with TXDOT and the Contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of November 2024.

- **ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District** – ONCOR is planning electrical line upgrades along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades intend to improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work is expected to start in Summer of 2022.



FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 136 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 105 EMS calls
 - 12 motor vehicle accidents
 - 1 building fire in DeSoto
 - 1 cooking fire in Duncanville
 - 3 grass fires in Duncanville
 - 1 rubbish fire in Duncanville
 - 1 mobile property fire in Duncanville
- The Department has no vacancies. Of our four new employees, two of the firefighters now count as staffing. Two others will not be counted as staffing until they complete the required training after attending a firefighter academy. Two new employees are paramedics certified with the Texas Department of Health Services and will be attending DeSoto's fire academy. The other two new employees are fire certified with the Texas Commission on Fire Protection and will be attending paramedic school.
- The Fire Department has completed all promotional exams except the Driver/Engineer position. The Civil Service Driver/Engineer promotional exam was administered on Wednesday, June 15, 2022. Two firefighters passed the exam. We are awaiting the appeal process to receive the final Civil Service Driver/Engineer list. The appeal process will be completed on July 21.

PERSONNEL

- Officer Fares Acosta is currently in his second phase of field training and is doing well.
- Officer Ralston Marshall completed field training on June 29.
- Cadet Jessica Determan began the basic peace officer academy on Monday, June 27, at the North Central Texas Council of Government.
- We have seven openings.
- Training and Personnel Division are currently working backgrounds of the police applicants
- Recruits Saul Vara and Brandon Dunn are doing very well at the Dallas County Sheriff's Office Police Academy. They are both scheduled to graduate at the end of July
 - This week the recruits learned tactical police driving, maneuvering an emergency vehicle at high speeds while still maintaining control, perception drills focusing on driving obstacles, and stopping.



DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Economic Development

- 42 Duncanville small businesses were approved for grant assistance by the Duncanville City Council on June 27 to address economic and workforce challenges brought on by the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Worked with a retail center owner and one of their tenants to become compliant with zoning regulations and achieve a certificate of occupancy.
- Continued assisting other departments on a water infrastructure grant.

Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 84 inspections (including re-inspections) and currently have 31 open cases.
- The Health Inspector conducted 21 health inspections this week, including a complaint referral from the Texas Department of Agriculture. The TDA complaint concerned an illegal summer food service program and unsafe food handling.
- Two food establishments were informed of pending disconnection of water service due to unpaid bills.
- The Health Inspector, Parks and Recreation staff, and Building Inspection staff met to finalize food vendors for the July 4th event.

Building Inspections

- A total of 1,797 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; one new property was registered this week. Eighty-three inspections were completed since the previous update: thirty-nine passed, thirty-seven failed, and seven were canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1038 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- 93 permits were issued, and 178 inspections were conducted. Ten mobile vending units have been inspected to date. Five were inspected this week.

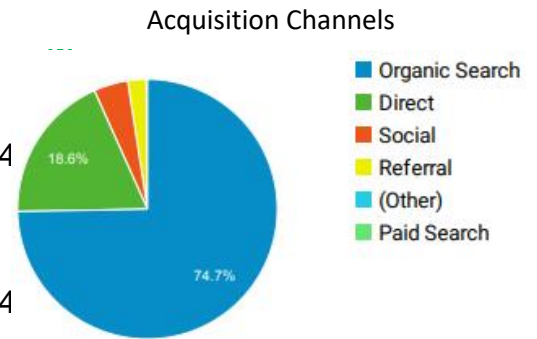

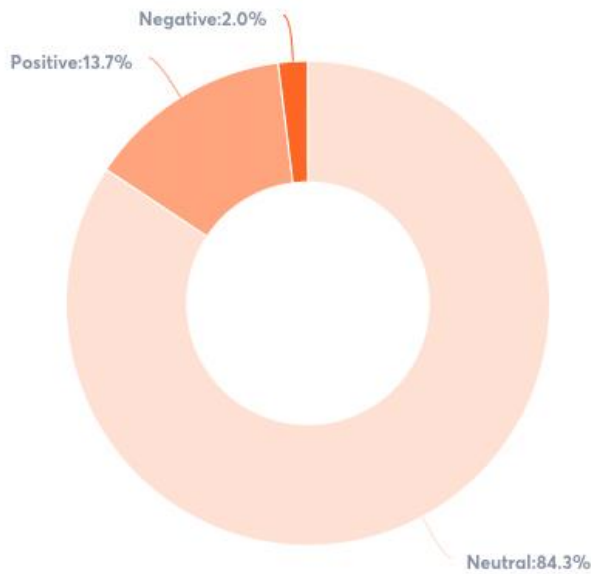
