Street Division

- Installed temporary asphalt level-ups at 1300-1400 S. Main and 1100 Briar Hill.
- Removed brush in right-of-way at 226 Cedar and 907 Kings Ct.

- Repaired sixteen potholes on the 900 Block of Sanders.
- Set up detours and assisted PD with road closures for July 4th Parade and Fireworks.
- Assisted Parks Department in cleaning debris from fireworks event at Duncanville Independent School District Bus Barn and Freeman St.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 49.01 MG this reporting period, June 27-July 3, 2022, down from 50.163 MG the previous week. The daily peak water demand occurred on Friday, July 1, 2022, when 7.474 MG was used. There were 0.0 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Approximately 168,203 gallons of water were lost, one hydrant was flushed, and seven valves were exercised. One hydrant was repaired.
- Crews responded to three sewer calls and cleaned 18,650 ft. of sewer line in the Merribrook, Memory, Melody, and Cliffwood areas (La Mexicana).
- Over ten right-of-way locates were completed.
- The Solid Waste Division received four calls with scheduling questions and four complaints: trash, bulk, and brush.
- Three recycle bins were distributed to residents.

CIP Construction

• E. Danieldale Road Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67) – The City's contractor, Pavecon, continued removing the existing eastbound concrete beginning at S. Main St. Their subcontractor, M-CO, is working on the 18-inch water main. Other subcontractors continue to work on finishing the sod and 12-foot trail on the north side of the road.

• Forest Hills Ramps Reconstruction – The City of Duncanville and the Dallas County Planning & Development Department, via the federally funded HUD Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, are reconstructing and improving the reinforced concrete ramps and sidewalks at four intersections in the Forest Hills Subdivision. The City's contractor, Northstar Construction, LLC, continued setting the concrete formwork, pouring new ramps, and pouring new sidewalks at the Alexander Ave. – Alexander Ct. intersection.



The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project - Green Ribbon Project construction commenced on October 11, 2021, with estimated completion now scheduled to occur in July of 2022. In addition to site and irrigation improvements, the contractor is installing piers for the Wintergreen Road monument and pouring concrete for the footings. Landscape planting is expected to occur this month.





• Fire Station #1 – Staff and BRW Architects completed the 100% Construction Drawings. CORE Construction, the Construction Manager at Risk, put the project out for bid. A "Subcontractor Outreach Event" was conducted on March 22, 2022, at the Senior Center from 4:00 pm-6:00 pm, and a Virtual Pre-bid meeting was held on March 24, 2022. CORE opened bids on April 7, 2022. Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement in June 2022. Construction should begin in September of this year, with completion anticipated in September of 2023.




Other Construction

- TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd to Hampton Rd TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd in Duncanville to Hampton Rd in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT plans to relocate Cockrell Hill Rd Texas U-Turn from the northeast side of the bridge (not desired) to the southwest side of the bridge (desired). The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction meeting with TXDOT and the Contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of November 2024.
- ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District ONCOR is planning electrical line upgrades along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades should improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work is expected to start in Summer of 2022.

ONCOR Transmission Line Work @ W. Camp Wisdom Rd & N. Cedar Ridge.
On July 29, 2021, staff met with ONCOR to discuss the upcoming project to replace
transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. The ONCOR contractor finished
transferring the cables to the new towers along Camp Wisdom Rd and N. Cedar
Ridge Drive and removed the existing towers. They will be removing the tower
foundations in the coming weeks.



FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 160 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - o 97 EMS calls.
 - 9 motor vehicle accidents.
 - o 2 vehicle fires in Duncanville.
 - 3 brush fires; 1 in DeSoto and 2 in Duncanville.
 - 3 grass fires in Duncanville.
 - 1 dumpster fire in Duncanville.
 - 1 fence fire in Duncanville.
- The Department has one vacancy as of July 6. One of our Driver/Engineers has taken a position in another organization. We will have another vacancy in two weeks for a total of two vacancies. Of our four new employees, two of the firefighters now count as staffing. The other two new employees will not be counted as staffing until they complete a firefighter academy. Two new employees are paramedics certified by the Texas Department of Health Services and will attend DeSoto's fire academy. The other two new employees are fire certified with the Texas Commission on Fire Protection and will attend paramedic school.
- The Fire Department has completed all promotional exams except the Driver/ Engineer position. The Civil Service Driver/Engineer promotional exam was administered on Wednesday, June 15, 2022. Two firefighters passed the exam. We await the appeal process on July 21, 2022, to receive the final Civil Service Driver/Engineer list. The Department has one vacant Driver/Engineer position.
- The National Weather Service in Fort Worth issued an Excessive Heat Warning for North Central Texas, which will remain in effect until 9:00 p.m. on Sunday. Hot temperatures and high humidity will increase the risk for heat-related illnesses. Drink plenty of fluids and stay in an air-conditioned building if possible.
- Paramedics received continuing education (CE) this week. The education was on Hypo and Hyperglycemia.
- The Fire Department and CERT participated in the 4th of July celebration. The Department was involved in unified command with the Police Department. The Department provided an ambulance, EMS cart for patient transport out of the park, a brush truck at the fireworks site, and a fire apparatus downwind of the shoot for any fires that may have started due to the fireworks. CERT provided lost and found, lost child recovery, first aid, and a cooling station for those who may have gotten overheated in the park. The fireworks were a great success from in-depth planning by city staff.

Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 89 inspections (including reinspections) and currently have a total of 56 open cases.
- The Health inspector conducted 27 health inspections last week. The Health Inspector has been working diligently with the area fitness center, school, and hotels to ensure that swimming pools are safe and clean for our citizens and visitors.

Building Inspections

- A total of 1,781 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; four new properties were registered since the last update. Thirty-Six inspections were completed since the previous update; eightteen passed, fourteen failed, and four were canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, and missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1043 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- 49 permits were issued this week, and 94 inspections were conducted.

- Seven properties are no longer operating as short-term rentals.
- Eight property owners have not responded.
- Final notices are expected to be mailed out this month.

- Summer Reading Club at the Duncanville Library is off to a wonderful start. Nearly 700 happy and excited visitors attended our kickoff party. We had games, giveaways, and lots of free treats. Snow-cones from Kona Ice and rice-Krispy treats from Kessler Baking Studio were just a just a couple of examples of the treats given out to attendees.
- We hosted 38 different children's programs including during the month of June, including story-times, puppet shows, crafts, and family movie nights.
- 1,880 exuberant participants attended our June programs, and we look forward to more smiling faces in July!




