Subject: Weekly Update

PUBLIC WORKS

Operational Updates:

Street Division

- Completed asphalt pavement repairs at 322-324 Harrington and 351 Linkcrest.
- Repaired utility cuts at 418 Willowbrook and 200 W. Center.
- Removed brush from the right-of-way at 1231 Jungle and 1709 Cedar Hill.
- Installed ADA ramps at 324-322 Harrington and 313 Merribrook.
- Marked 19 right-of-way way locates.
- Levelled up the street at 1700 Creekhaven and 1202 Briarmeade.
- Cleaned one inlet at 1430 Aaron Pl.
- Removed debris from the street at 1100 W. Danieldale.
- Cam-Crete, our pavement replacement contractor, continued pavement replacement activities on W. Wheatland between Santa Fe and Mercury.
- Nortex, the City of Duncanville FY 22 pavement lifting contractor, continued lifting uneven sidewalks on Omaha.
- Viking Construction began micro-surfacing asphalt streets located throughout the City. Viking has completed 40% of the project.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 55.165 million gallons this reporting period, August 1-7, 2022, down from 56.195 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 8.194 million gallons occurred on Monday, August 1. There were 0.0 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- There were five hydrants flushed and approximately 91,000 gallons of water loss.
- Crews responded to four sewer calls and cleaned 17,725 feet of sewer lines in the Merribrook area and at the Tortilla Factory. Crews also did a sewer dig and replaced a sewer line.
- Over ten right-of-way locates were completed.
- The Solid Waste Division received five scheduling questions and ten complaints: three trash, one bulk, five brush, and one recycle.
- Six recycle bins were distributed to residents.

CIP Construction

- **August 10, 2022, Community Meeting – Capital Improvement Projects in the Swan Ridge Area** – The City of Duncanville Public Works Department held a neighborhood meeting at the Hopkins Senior Center to provide information and answer questions regarding two upcoming capital improvement projects that will impact area residents of the Swan Ridge Addition: Swan Ridge Drive Street Reconstruction & Utility Improvements Project and Ten Mile Creek Retaining Wall & Drainage Improvements Project. Approximately twenty residents attended the meeting.

- **E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)** – M-CO, Pavecon’s subcontractor, continued work on the 18-inch water main by installing gate valve vaults and fire hydrants.

- **TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd to Hampton Rd** – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of November 2024.

- **Forest Hills Ramps Reconstruction** – The City of Duncanville and the Dallas County Planning & Development Department, via the federally funded HUD Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, are funding construction improvements to the reinforced concrete ramps and sidewalks at four intersections within the Forest Hills Subdivision. The City’s contractor, Northstar Construction, LLC, continued setting the concrete formwork and pouring the new concrete ramps and new sidewalk at the Freeman-Center intersection and Alexander Ave-Alexander Ct intersection. Northstar installed the new pedestrian pole foundations and is working to install the pedestrian push buttons at the Freeman-Center intersection within the coming week. Project completion is anticipated by the end of August.



- **The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project** – Green Ribbon Project construction commenced on October 11, 2021, with estimated completion now scheduled to occur in November 2022. In addition to site and irrigation improvements, the contractor is installing piers for the Wintergreen Road monument and pouring concrete for the footings. Landscape planting is expected to occur in September 2022.



- **Fire Station #1** – Staff and BRW Architects completed the 100% Construction Drawings. CORE Construction, the Construction Manager at Risk, put the project out for bid. A “Subcontractor Outreach Event” was conducted on March 22, 2022, at the Senior Center from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., and a Virtual Pre-bid meeting was held on March 24, 2022. CORE opened bids on April 7, 2022. Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement in June 2022. Notice of Intent to Award Contract was provided to Core Construction on July 20, 2022. Construction commencement should occur in October 2022, with completion anticipated in Fall 2023.



Other Construction

- **ONCOR Transmission Line Work at W. Camp Wisdom Rd. and N. Cedar Ridge** – Much of the work to replace transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. has been completed by Oncor’s contractor. The contractor removed the tower foundations and is working on sidewalk repairs.



- **ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District** – ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced.



POLICE DEPARTMENT

PERSONNEL

- Officer Fares Acosta is currently in his third phase of field training and is doing well. He is scheduled to complete field training at the end of August.
- Cadets Saul Vara and Brandon Dunn are currently attending the Department's In-Service academy and will begin their field training on August 14, 2022.
- We have seven openings for sworn personnel.
- Our next Police entrance examination is scheduled for September 24, 2022, at the Senior Center. All who qualify for employment may complete the online application at <https://www.duncanville.com/departments/police/recruitment/>.
- Cadet Jessica Determan is in the basic peace officer academy at the North Central Texas Council of Government and is doing well. Her recap of this week's training is below:
 - Classes: Arrest, Search & Seizure, Family Violence, Child Victims and Related Assault Offenses, and Criminal Investigation: Auto Theft
 - **Code of Criminal Procedure Test - 98%**
 - "We had Defensive Tactics this week in addition to our classes. We incorporated handcuffing in there as well. The Family Violence class was taught by the director of the academy, Ms. Hollingsworth. It was an honor to sit under her experience and wisdom."



FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 95 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 67 EMS calls
 - 7 motor vehicle accidents
 - 1 brush fire
 - 2 grass fires
 - 1 building fire
 - 1 cooking fire
- The Department has two vacancies. Interviews for the vacant positions were held on August 1, 2022. We will schedule a Chiefs interview for one of the candidates. The other two candidates are no longer being considered.
- The National Weather Service in Fort Worth forecasts temperatures in the upper 90s next week. Hot temperatures and high humidity will increase the risk for heat-related illnesses. Drink plenty of fluids and stay in an air-conditioned building if possible.
- Dallas County remains under an outdoor burn ban due to high temperatures and drought conditions. **Open flame cooking can be done outdoors during a burn ban**, however, the flames must be completely enclosed in the cooking device.

DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Economic Development

- Continuing to process ARPA applications for disbursement.
- Met with the Economic Development Director of Cary, NC to discuss best practices and innovative redevelopment strategies.
- Met with a local business owner to discuss economic development programs and the ARPA assistance for small businesses.
- Participated in the City Council Budget Workshop.

Neighborhood Services

- Mr. Nathan Warren, Senior Planner, joined our team on Monday.
- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 158 inspections (including re-inspections) and have a total of 54 open cases.
- The Health Inspector conducted 30 health inspections this week.
- Applications for the Fall 2022 PIP Days are available now until August 31, 2022. Staff has been aiding in getting the word out on the PIP program, and we have received a number of application requests.
- Interviews for the vacant Building Inspector position are ongoing.

Building Inspections

- A total of 1,794 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; three new properties were registered since the last update. Twenty-six inspections were completed since the previous update; ten passed, fourteen failed, and two were canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were the absence of GFCI protection as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1077 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.

- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$380,186.89 has been collected. A total of \$8,167.62 has been collected since January 1, 2022, including \$1,525.60 this week.
- This week 66 permits were issued, and 115 inspections were conducted. To date, we have inspected 10 mobile vending units.

 - Staff sent comments on August 5 and are waiting on clients to submit revisions.
- **Ongoing:**
 - **Comp Plan Five-Year Update**
 - Planning is at the beginning stages of updating the Comprehensive Plan.
 - Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on the Downtown District area, discussing the incorporation of new areas, and considering ways to incorporate green energy.
 - Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.
 - **Short-Term Rental Registration Program**
 - Twenty notification letters were mailed out to property owners on April 1, 2022.
 - One owner did not receive an initial notice but did respond.
 - Thirteen property owners have responded since initial notices were mailed out on April 1.
 - Five properties are currently going through the Specific Use Permit process.
 - Eight properties are no longer operating as short-term rentals.
 - Seven property owners have not responded.
 - One Property was granted a Specific Use Permit by City Council on July 19, 2022; the owner is in the process of registering/inspecting the property.
 - Final notices were mailed on August 2.

PARKS AND RECREATION

- BrightView Landscape Services completed its required mowing cycles for the week of August 1 - 6, 2022. Staff continues to meet weekly to discuss quality and scheduling issues.
