PUBLIC WORKS

Operational Updates:

Street Division

- Marked fifteen right-of-way locates.
- Street level-ups completed on N. Alexander and Silver Creek.
- Repaired utility cuts on N. Hastings, Greentree, Little Creek, Cardinal Creek, and Silver Creek.
- Installed ADA ramps on Harrington and Melody.
- Removed spilled concrete from the street on S. Main.
- Patched potholes on Cedar Ridge Dr.


Utilities Division

- Water usage was 40.428 million gallons this reporting period, October 3-9, 2022, down from 40.899 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 6.001 million gallons occurred on Thursday, October 6. There were 0.0 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Nineteen hydrants were flushed, one valve was exercised, and an estimated water loss of 204,678 gallons occurred.
- Crews responded to three sewer calls, televised 144 feet of sewer line, and dug one new sewer service. 4,400 feet of sewer line were cleaned in the Capri, Venice, and Westridge areas.
- The Solid Waste Division received four scheduling questions and twenty-eight complaints: four trash, two bulk, twenty brush, and two special collections. Eight recycle bins were distributed.
- Operation Clean Duncanville occurred on Saturday, October 8, from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Numerous vehicles participated: 133 from zip code 75116, 170 from 75137, and the rest from other zip codes. The following table provides a breakdown of the number of vehicles by service:

CIP Construction

E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67) – M-CO, Pavecon's subcontractor, is installing the 16-inch water main and appurtenances, and completed the tie-in on Sunset Village Dr. Another subcontractor, Stenson, installed the curb ramp on the northeast corner of Main St. and Danieldale Rd. as well as retaining walls that were not completed in Phase 2.

 The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project – Green Ribbon Project construction commenced on October 11, 2021, with estimated completion now scheduled to occur in November 2022.





Fire Station #1 – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction to construct the new Fire Station #1 in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022, and monthly progress meetings started on September 7th. Construction has commenced. The Fire Station No. 1 Groundbreaking Ceremony is scheduled for October 25 at 10 a.m. Completion of the fire station is slated for Fall 2023.



Other Construction

- ONCOR Transmission Line Work at W. Camp Wisdom Rd. and N. Cedar Ridge – Much of the work to replace transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. has been completed by Oncor's contractor. The contractor removed the tower foundations and is working on sidewalk repairs.
- ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced



• TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd to Hampton Rd — TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. A meeting with the Mayor, staff, and TXDOT took place on Monday, August 22, to discuss construction improvements that could impair visibility at the Cityowned property located at 730 E. Interstate Highway 20. TXDOT provided plans and additional renderings to the City.



FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 129 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 91 EMS calls for service.
 - 9 motor vehicle accidents.
 - 1 building fire in Duncanville.
- Fire personnel are participating in live fire training with Desoto and Cedar Hill. This
 training is taking place at the Midlothian Fire Department training facility and is
 being led by Regional Training Chief Mark Madrid. All firefighters are required to
 participate in live fire training on an annual basis by the Texas Commission on Fire
 Protection. This training simulates fire scenes and encompasses multiple skills
 such as incident command, civilian rescue, firefighter rescue, forcible entry, and
 pump operations.
- The Fire Prevention Division completed 15 business inspections in the past week.
- Capt. Adam Langan, Fire Engineer Brent Nabors, along with Firefighters/Paramedics Peyton Southard and Armando Martinez visited Smith Elementary to talk to the kids about what firefighters do and show them all the equipment and gear that is used.
- Emergency Management Operations Coordinator, Lauren Sanchez, submitted the
 updated Emergency Plan Annex M to the State. This annex is updated every five
 years, per State requirement, and outlines Duncanville's resource management in
 case of a disaster. She has also been developing a Memorandum of
 Understanding for Duncanville, Desoto, Cedar Hill, and Lancaster to secure child
 reunification locations and backup locations.

Building and Inspections

• A total of 1,822 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; one new property was registered this week. Thirty-two inspections were completed since the previous update; seventeen passed, eleven failed, and four were canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were the absence of GFCI protection as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,236 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.

- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$382,245.17 has been collected. A total of \$10,225.90 has been collected since January 1, 2022. This week we collected \$547.30
- This week 87 permits were issued, and 171 inspections were conducted.

Ongoing:

Comprehensive Plan Five-Year Update:

- Planning is at the beginning stages of updating the Comprehensive Plan.
- Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on the Downtown District area, discussing the incorporation of new areas, and considering ways to incorporate green energy.
- Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.

Short-Term Rental Registration Program:

- Six final notices and four initial notices were mailed out on August
 2.
- Six properties are going through the Specific Use Permit process.
- Since August 2, one property is no longer operating as a shortterm rental and three properties have registered as long-term rentals.
- Five property owners have not responded to the notices sent out on August 2.
- Three properties have been granted a Specific Use Permit by the Council.

PARKS AND RECREATION

- Staff inspected and monitored contractor performance and addressed specification issues on the Highway 67 Green Ribbon project.
- Staff inspected landscape plants being installed at Cockrell Hill landscape beds.
