Subject: Weekly Update

PUBLIC WORKS

Operational Updates:

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 31.523 million gallons this reporting period, October 24-30, 2022, down from 37.401 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.721 million gallons occurred on Monday, October 24. There were 4.63 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- One hydrant was flushed and three valves were exercised.
- An estimated 76,936 gallons of water loss occurred, including main breaks.
- One service line and two water main breaks were repaired.
- Crews responded to five sewer calls and cleaned 15,750 feet of sewer in the Huntington, Redman, Greenway, and Woodhaven areas.
- The Solid Waste Division received ten complaints: one trash, one bulk, and eight brush. One recycling bin was distributed.

Street Division

- Marked three right-of-way locates.
- Set out barricades for a high school football game.
- Made repairs to the street on Woodacre.
- Repaired sidewalks on Willowbrook and Woodacre.
- Repaired curb and gutter on Woodacre.
- Repaired utility cut on Oriole.
- Patched a pothole on E. Cherry.

CIP Construction:

- **E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)** – M-CO, Pavecon's subcontractor, continued the 16-inch water main installation.

- **FY22 Pipebursting** – Vortex is installing sanitary sewer mains by pipe bursting in the Forest Hills subdivision.



- **The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project** – Green Ribbon Project construction commenced on October 11, 2021, with estimated completion now scheduled to occur in December 2022. The landscape monument at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Interstate Highway 20 is being constructed.



- **Fire Station 271** – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022 and monthly progress meetings began on September 7, 2022. Construction has commenced, and a ribbon cutting that was scheduled for October 25 is being rescheduled. The anticipated completion date is Fall 2023.



Other Construction

- **ONCOR Transmission Line Work at W. Camp Wisdom Rd. and N. Cedar Ridge** – Much of the work to replace transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. has been completed by Oncor's contractor. The contractor removed the tower foundations and is working on sidewalk repairs.
- **ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District** – ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced.



- **TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd.** – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. Austin Bridge is constructing the Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 142 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 109 EMS calls.
 - Eleven motor vehicle accidents.
 - One trash fire.
 - Two structure fires: one in Cedar Hill and one in DeSoto.
- The Fire Prevention Division completed eight fire inspections and five Certificate of Occupancy inspections.
- The Department has two vacancies. The current Civil Service list is exhausted. The Department will be working with Human Resources to schedule a new Civil Service test date.
- Firefighters Tony Jones and Taylor Arrington are attending Paramedic school.
- Ross Glauben and Bryant Medhus graduated from DeSoto Fire Academy. The Department congratulates both of them for their dedication to successfully completing the academy. They are currently assigned to shift work and are in the process of completing training with the Department to be included in staffing.
- Fire Marshal Steve Wakeland attended the Texas Fire Marshals Annual Conference last week. The conference provides an outlet for the exchange of the most up-to-date information and developments in fire prevention. This provides the opportunity for networking with fire prevention specialists from around the State of Texas.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

PERSONNEL

- Cadet Brandon Dunn is currently in field training and is expected to become an independently-working patrol officer in mid-December.
- Cadet Jessica Determan is in the basic peace officer academy and will graduate on December 9.
- Training and Personnel is actively conducting background investigations on applicants.
- We have eight openings for sworn personnel.

COMMUNITY CORNER

- The Police Department participated in the Halloween Boo Bash at the Duncanville Field House.
- The Department also participated in the DEA National Drug Takeback program on Saturday, October 29. The program is a national platform used to retrieve expired medication from residents, so that the medication can be disposed of properly rather than falling into the wrong hands.
- Crime Prevention Officer Michelle Arias participated in the Fall Festival event at Smith Elementary.

Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 200 inspections, including re-inspections, and have a total of eighty-three open cases.

Building and Inspections

- A total of 1,838 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; one new property was registered this week. Thirty-seven inspections were completed since the previous update; twenty passed, thirteen failed, and four were canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,269 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- This week sixty-nine permits were issued and 183 inspections were conducted. Eleven mobile vending units have been inspected to date.

 - **Comprehensive Plan Five-Year Update:**
 - Planning is at the beginning stages of updating the Comprehensive Plan.
 - Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on the Downtown District area, discussing the incorporation of new areas, and considering ways to incorporate green energy.
 - Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.
 - **Short-Term Rental Registration Program:**
 - Six final notices and four initial notices were mailed on August 2.
 - Five properties are going through the Specific Use Permit process.
 - One property is no longer operating as a short-term rental and four properties have registered as long-term rentals.
 - Four properties have been granted a Specific Use Permit by the Council.

PARKS AND RECREATION

Parks:

- The Keep Duncanville Beautiful Board is hosting the annual Arbor Day Tree Planting and Celebration event this Saturday, November 5, 2022. Tree saplings will be given away while supplies last, between 9:00 and 11:00 a.m., by the tennis court parking lot at Armstrong Park.
- Staff inspected and monitored contractor performance and addressed Highway 67 Green Ribbon project specification issues. We also inspected the final four thousand landscape plants on the project.
- Staff continues to plant Fall annuals at city facilities and rights-of-way.
- BrightView Landscape Services completed 29 of the 31 required mowing cycles for October 24-30. Staff continues to meet weekly to discuss quality and scheduling performance issues. Brightview is assisting in the Fall planting and beautification efforts in front of City Hall. Staff met with the Plano division which will be taking over the city's account on November 1, 2022. During the meeting, we reviewed the City's expectations and assigned high-priority properties.
- Staff began the installation of the Christmas lights in the trees at Armstrong Park.
- Installation of the new fitness equipment continues at Red Bird Park.

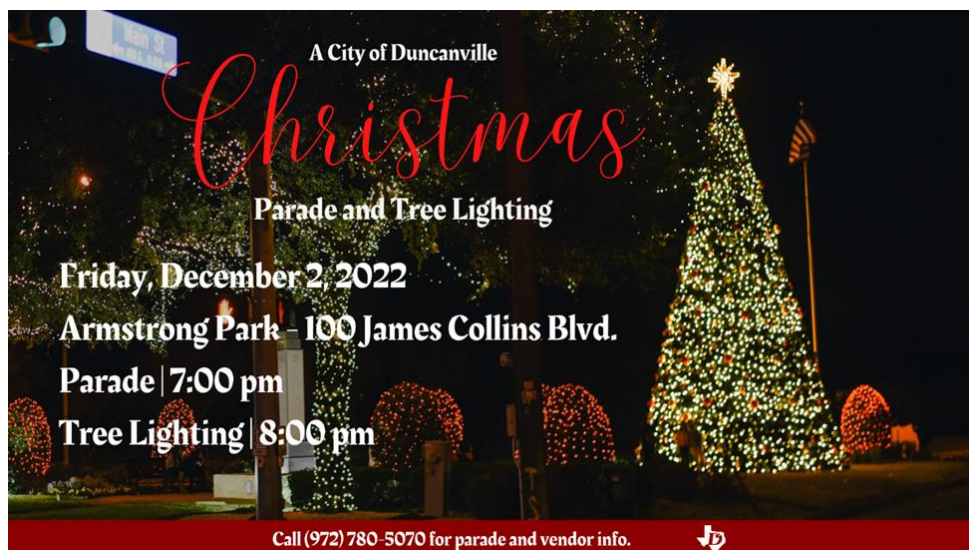

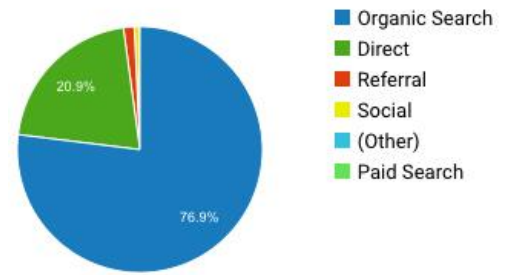

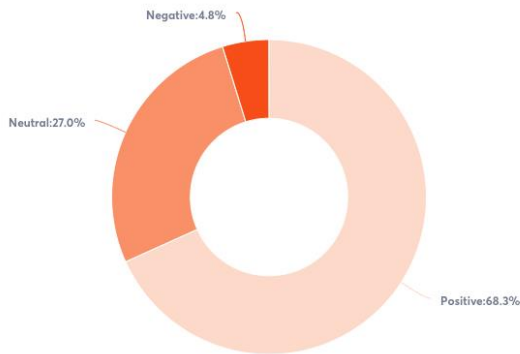
