PUBLIC WORKS

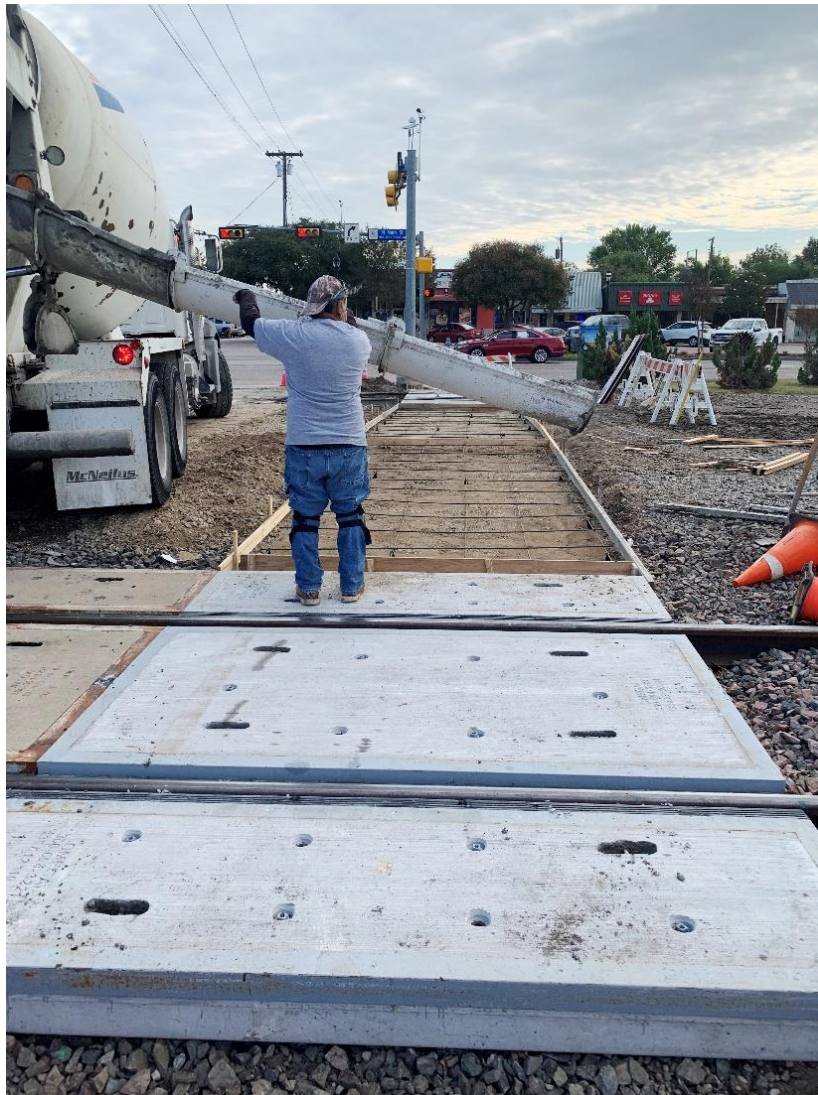
Operational Updates:

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 31.051 million gallons this reporting period, October 31-November 6, 2022, down from 31.523 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.614 million gallons occurred On Sunday, November 6. There were 0.64 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Eighteen hydrants were flushed, and seven valves were exercised.
- An estimated 226,291 gallons of water loss occurred, including a water main break and leaks.
- One service line and one water main break were repaired.
- Crews responded to seven sewer calls and cleaned 19,250 ft. of sewer lines in the Redman, Kensington, and Wellington areas.
- The Solid Waste Division received one complaint for trash not being picked up. Five recycle bins were distributed.

Street Division

- Repaired utility cuts on Kelly and Sanders.
- Made repairs to the street on W. Davis.
- Patched forty-two potholes at various locations throughout the City.
- Inspected twenty-five headwalls: cleaned ten and removed 8.25 cubic yards of trash and debris
- Cleaned a culvert pipe on Aaron Pl.
- Installed new sidewalk, curb and gutter, and ADA ramp at 100 W. Davis railroad crossing.

CIP Construction:

- **E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)** – M-CO, Pavecon’s subcontractor, continued the 16-inch water main installation.

- **FY22 Pipe bursting** – Vortex is installing sanitary sewer mains by pipe bursting along E. Center St. in the Forest Hills subdivision.



- **The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project** – Green Ribbon Project construction commenced on October 11, 2021, with estimated completion now scheduled to occur in December 2022. The landscape monument at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Interstate Highway 20 is being constructed.





- **Fire Station 271** – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022 and monthly progress meetings began on September 7, 2022. Construction has commenced, and a ribbon cutting that was scheduled for October 25 is being rescheduled. The anticipated completion date is Fall 2023.



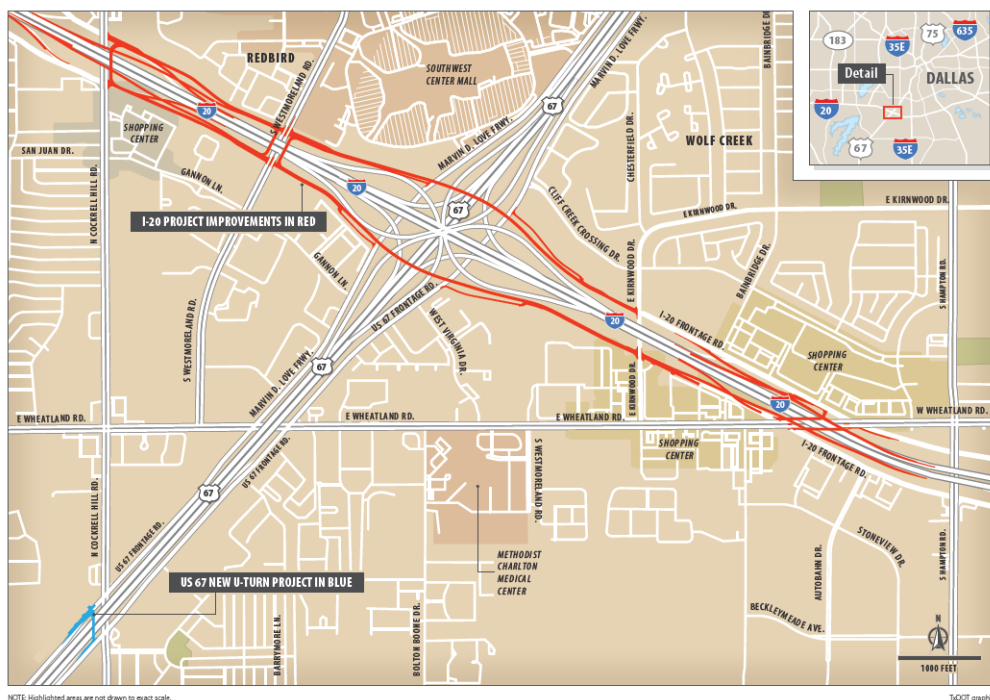
Other Construction

- **ONCOR Transmission Line Work at W. Camp Wisdom Rd. and N. Cedar Ridge** – Much of the work to replace transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. has been completed by Oncor's contractor. The contractor removed the tower foundations and is working on sidewalk repairs.

- **ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District** – ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system’s capacity in that area. Work has commenced.



- **TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd.** – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. Austin Bridge is constructing the Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67.



FISCAL SERVICES

Municipal Court:

Utility Customer Service Office:

- On November 08, we processed 113 water disconnections for cycle four customers with a past due balance.
- The Utility Customer Service field crew replaced one customer metered curb stop.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 124 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 94 EMS calls.
 - Fourteen motor vehicle accidents.
 - One passenger vehicle fire.
 - Two structure fires.
 - One cooking fire.
- The Department has two vacancies. The current Civil Service list is exhausted. The Department will be working with Human Resources to schedule a new Civil Service test date.
- Firefighters Tony Jones and Taylor Arrington are attending Paramedic school.
- Ross Glauben and Bryant Medhus graduated from DeSoto Fire Academy. They are currently assigned to shift work and are in the process of completing training with the Department to be included in staffing.
- Fire Marshal Steve Wakeland is attending the Fire Executive Management Training Program this week. The program will address the professional qualifications for fire marshals and evaluate the knowledge, skills, and abilities needed to meet essential tasks of the job based on National Fire Protection Association standards. The program will also focus on the day-to-day operations of the job as well as community risk assessments and resource distribution.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

PERSONNEL

- Cadet Brandon Dunn is currently in field training and is expected to graduate in mid-December.
- Cadet Jessica Determan is in the basic peace officer academy and will graduate on December 9.
- Training and Personnel are actively conducting background investigations on applicants.
- We have eight openings for sworn personnel.
- The department held a promotional ceremony for Assistant Chief Christopher Freis and Sergeant Tommy Brough.



COMMUNITY CORNER

- The Police Department attended a college recruiting event at the University of North Texas at Dallas.

Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 94 inspections, including re-inspections, and have 38 open cases.

Building and Inspections

- A total of 1,846 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; eight new properties were registered this week. Twenty-eight inspections were completed since the previous update; sixteen passed, eleven failed, and one was canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,277 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$383,226.30 has been collected. A total of \$11,207.03 has been collected since January 1, 2022, including \$394.56 this week.
- This week 70 permits were issued, and 171 inspections were conducted.
- Angelica Garcia will be resigning from her position as Building Inspections Coordinator on December 3.

- **Ongoing:**

 - Planning is at the beginning stages of updating the Comprehensive Plan.
 - Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on the Downtown District area, discussing the incorporation of new areas, and considering ways to incorporate green energy.
 - Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.
 - **Short-Term Rental Registration Program:**
 - Six final notices and four initial notices were mailed on August 2.
 - Four properties are going through the Specific Use Permit process.
 - One property is no longer operating as a short-term rental and four properties have registered as long-term rentals.
 - Four property owners have not responded.
 - Four properties were granted a Specific Use Permit by the Council.

PARKS AND RECREATION

Parks:

- On November 5, the Keep Duncanville Beautiful Board hosted an Arbor Day Celebration at Armstrong Park. Tree saplings were provided for the community to plant at their properties.
- Staff inspected and monitored contractor performance and addressed Highway 67 Green Ribbon project specification issues. Staff inspected the final four thousand landscape plants on the project.
- BrightView Landscape Services completed all the required mowing cycles for the week of October 31-November 5, 2022. Staff continues to meet weekly to discuss quality and scheduling performance issues.
- Staff continues the installation of the Christmas lights in the trees at Armstrong Park.
- Installation of the new fitness equipment continues at Red Bird Park.
- Staff cleaned up two illegal dumping sites.
- Staff set the PD sign up and replanted recent landscape plants caused by a vehicle accident.
