## **PUBLIC WORKS**

### **Operational Updates:**

#### **Utilities Division**

- Water usage was 28.45 million gallons during this reporting period, November 21-27, 2022, down from 29.267 million gallons the previous week., The daily peak water demand of 4.363 million gallons occurred on Tuesday, November 22, 2022. There were 2.82 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Ten hydrants were flushed.
- An estimated 80,500 gallons of water loss occurred.
- Crews responded to four sewer calls and cleaned 6,350 feet of sewer lines in the Winona Gardens, The Greene, and Green Hills additions.
- The Solid Waste Division distributed two recycle bins.

#### **Street Division**

- Marked eight right-of-way locates.
- Placed barricades on E. Center Street due to a fallen utility pole and removed a tree blocking the street on W. Red Bird.
- Inspected 511 inlets; all were clean.
- Inspected twenty-five headwalls: cleaned seven and removed five cubic yards of debris.
- Repaired utility cuts on Monroe, Rock Springs, and E. Fairmeadows.
- Patched 211 potholes at various locations throughout the City.
- Continued excavating a ditch starting on N. Royal Oaks and proceeding northbound.

### **CIP Construction:**

• E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67) – M-CO, Pavecon's subcontractor, continued the 16-inch water main installation.

Fire Station 271 – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement
with CORE Construction in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held
on August 10, 2022, and monthly progress meetings began on September 7.
Construction has commenced. The Fire Station 271 Groundbreaking Ceremony
was rescheduled due to muddy conditions following heavy rains over the
Thanksgiving weekend. Completion of the fire station is slated for Fall 2023.



#### **Other Construction**

- ONCOR Transmission Line Work at W. Camp Wisdom Rd. and N. Cedar Ridge – Much of the work to replace transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. has been completed by Oncor's contractor. The contractor removed the tower foundations and is working on sidewalk repairs.
- ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced.



• TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd. – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. Austin Bridge is constructing the Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67.

# **FIRE DEPARTMENT**

- The Fire Department responded to 169 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:

  - 3 natural or LPG gas leaks,
  - 2 structure fires.
- The Fire Prevention Division completed three plan reviews, two system checks, and two Certificate of Occupancy inspections. The division finished an arson case on Wednesday.
- The Department has two vacancies. There is a Civil Service exam scheduled for December 17 which consists of a written exam and physical agility test.
- Firefighters Tony Jones and Taylor Arrington are attending Paramedic school.

## POLICE DEPARTMENT

### **PERSONNEL**

- Detective Andrew Armstrong resigned from the Police Department after almost fifteen years of service. We wish him well in his future endeavors outside of law enforcement.
- We will be hosting a civil service exam on January 21, 2023.
- Cadet Brandon Dunn is in field training and expected to graduate in mid-December.
- Cadet Jessica Determan is in the basic peace officer academy and will graduate on December 9.
- Cadet Paul Becerra is in the basic peace office academy and will graduate in April 2023.
- Training and Personnel are actively conducting background investigations on applicants.
- We have nine openings for sworn personnel.

## **Building and Inspections**

- A total of 1,850 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; one new property was registered this week. Twelve inspections were completed since the previous update: ten passed, two failed, and zero were canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,303 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- This week 31 permits were issued, and 88 inspections were conducted.

### **Neighborhood Services**

- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 126 inspections, including reinspections, and have a total of 55 open cases.
- The Administrative Assistant, Neighborhood Services Officer, Building Inspection Coordinator, and Health Inspector have now been filled. The new hires will begin filling the roles over throughout the next four weeks respectively.

## Ongoing:

## Comprehensive Plan Five-Year Update:

- Planning is at the beginning stages of updating the Comprehensive Plan.
- Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on the Downtown District area, discussing the incorporation of new areas, and considering ways to incorporate green energy.
- Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.

## Short-Term Rental Registration Program:

- Six final notices and four initial notices were mailed on August 2.
- Four properties are going through the Specific Use Permit process.
- One property is no longer operating as a short-term rental and four properties have registered as long-term rentals.
- Four property owners have not responded.
- Four properties were granted a Specific Use Permit by the Council.






