## **PUBLIC WORKS**

#### **Utilities Division**

- Water usage was 29.03 million gallons during this reporting period, November 28 through December 4, down from 28.45 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.416 million gallons occurred on Thursday, December 1, 2022. There were 0.0 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- One hydrant was flushed.
- An estimated 35,000 gallons of water loss occurred.
- Crews responded to nine sewer calls and cleaned 450 ft of sewer lines.
- Located and dug up sewer service for a new home.
- The Solid Waste Division had eight trash and two bulk complaints, one backflow question, and one special collection interview for a disabled resident. Two recycle bins were distributed this week.

#### **Street Division**

- Marked ten right-of-way locates.
- Responded to one callout to remove brush on the sidewalk.
- Inspected twenty-five headwalls, cleaned seven headwalls, and removed five cubic yards of debris.
- Repaired utility cuts on Kennedy, Van Rowe, Woodhaven, and Pebble.
- Patched potholes on W. Fairmeadows, Kensington, and N. Greenstone.
- Set up detours and traffic control for the Duncanville Christmas Parade.

• **FY22 Pipe bursting** – Vortex is installing sanitary sewer mains by pipe bursting along E. Center St. in the Forest Hills subdivision.



 The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project – Green Ribbon Project construction commenced on October 11, 2021, with estimated completion now scheduled to occur in January 2023. The landscape monument at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Interstate Highway 20 is almost complete.




Fire Station 271 – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022 and monthly progress meetings began on September 7, 2022. Construction has commenced. The Fire Station 271 Groundbreaking Ceremony, previously scheduled for October 25, was rescheduled to December 1 at 10:00 a.m. Completion of the fire station is slated for Fall 2023.




#### Other Construction

- ONCOR Transmission Line Work at W. Camp Wisdom Rd. and N. Cedar Ridge – Much of the work to replace transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. has been completed by Oncor's contractor. The contractor removed the tower foundations and is working on sidewalk repairs.
- ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced.



• TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd. – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. Austin Bridge is constructing the Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67.



## **FIRE DEPARTMENT**

- The Fire Department responded to 169 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
  - o 101 EMS calls.
  - 8 calls for assistance.
  - 14 motor structure fires.
  - 2 outside rubbish, trash or waste fires.
  - o 2 natural or LPG gas leaks.
  - o 1 grass fire.
- The Fire Prevention Division completed three inspections, five plan reviews, and two Certificate of Occupancy inspections. The division taught one cardiopulmonary resuscitation class.
- The Department has two vacancies. A Civil Service exam which consists of a written exam and physical agility test is scheduled for December 17. There are 41 applicants; 80-90 applicants is standard.
- Firefighters Tony Jones and Taylor Arrington are attending Paramedic school.
- Three personnel attended a heavy rescue class.



## **POLICE DEPARTMENT**

#### **COMMUNITY CORNER**

- Chief LiVigni, Assistant Chief Stogner, and Assistant Chief Freis attended the Village Tech District safety meeting. Chief LiVigni discussed the ongoing traffic concerns of citizens living around Village Tech, and asked the school for assistance to minimize traffic issues as much as possible.
- The department partnered with local churches receiving toy donations for the Joys and Toys Community Christmas Concert. Donated toys will go to the Santa Cop Program.



#### **PERSONNEL**

- We will be hosting a civil service exam on January 21, 2023.
- Cadet Brandon Dunn is in field training and expected to graduate in mid-December.
- Cadet Jessica Determan is in the basic peace officer academy and will graduate on December 9.
- Cadet Paul Becerra is in the basic peace office academy and will graduate in April 2023.
- Training and Personnel are actively conducting background investigations on applicants.
- We have nine openings for sworn personnel.

## **DEVELOPMENT SERVICES**

#### **Economic Development**

- The Duncanville Community and Economic Development Corporation's regular meeting was held on December 5.
- D Squared Catering, LLC, was awarded a Demo, Redevelopment, Reuse and Infrastructure grant in the amount of \$22,374.17 to install a grease trap and related water and service infrastructure for a building located at 519 East Highway 67.
- Fiesta Furniture Outlet, LLC was awarded a Demo, Redevelopment, Reuse and Infrastructure grant in the amount of \$80,000 to install an underground fire line to enable the installation of a fire sprinkler system for a building located at 642 East Highway 67.
- Continued to support site selection for Project Hamsa.
- Continued to work on marketing outreach efforts.

#### **Building and Inspections**

- A total of 1,853 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; three
  new properties were registered since the last update. Twenty-eight inspections
  were completed this week: twelve passed, thirteen failed, and three were canceled.
  The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection,
  as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,309
  Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$384,251.30 has been collected. A
  total of \$12,232.03 has been collected since January 1, 2022, including \$150.00
  this week.
- This week forty-six permits were issued, and 174 inspections were conducted.
- To date we have inspected 11 mobile vending units. No mobile vending units were inspected this week.

#### **Neighborhood Services**

- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 96 inspections, including re-inspections, and have forty-two open cases.
- The Administrative Assistant, Neighborhood Service Officer, Building Inspection Coordinator, and Health Inspector positions have been filled. The new hires are scheduled to be onboarded within the next four weeks.
- The Director of Planning and Neighborhood Services will be presenting at a District
   4 gathering this weekend at the Senior Center.

  - Planned Development request was approved by City Council on October 18.
  - The building permit application was submitted. The architectural and engineering plans are being reviewed by staff.
- New Development at 704 North Main Street.
  - A site plan was submitted on August 30.
  - A building permit applicated was submitted on November 18 and is under staff review.
- Expansion at 803, 807, 809, and 811 South Cockrell Hill Road.
  - Replat was approved November 28 at the Planning and Zoning meeting.
  - Zoning change hearing is scheduled for Planning and Zoning meeting on December 12.

#### • Ongoing:

- Comprehensive Plan Five-Year Update:
  - Planning is at the beginning stages of updating the Comprehensive Plan.
  - The Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on the Downtown District area, discussing the incorporation of new areas, and considering ways to incorporate green energy.
  - Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.
- Short-Term Rental Registration Program:
  - Six final notices and four initial notices were mailed on August 2.
  - Four properties are going through the Specific Use Permit process.
  - One property is no longer operating as a short-term rental, and four properties have registered as long-term rentals.
  - Four property owners have not responded.
  - Four properties were granted a Specific Use Permit by the Council.







Caden Clinton is a firefighter with the Duncanville Fire Department. "I'm from Carthage. It's about as far east as you can get in Texas. grew up with good Southern and Cajun food. I began cooking with my grandma, Annie Girl, around the age of 4 or 5. #### **Baked Breakfast Casserole**

Nonstick cooking spray I bag frozen tater tots

- I lb. breakfast sausage, cooked
- 5-6 slices bacon, cooked and crumbled
- 10-12 eggs 1 jar Pace Chunky Salsa
- I small white onion, finely chopped
- 2 jalapeños, finely chopped 1 cup cheese, shredded
- I. Preheat the oven to 425 F. Spray a casserole dish with nonstick cooking spray 2. Add a single layer of tots to the pan. Add the sausage and bacon evenly over the tots. Crack the eggs into a bowl; add the salsa;

whisk together. Pour the egg mixture evenly over the tots. Sprinkle the onions and jalapeños over the casserole. Add a layer of cheese; cover with foil.

3. Bake for 25-35 minutes, until cooked through. Remove the foil; broil a few minutes to melt the cheese. Remove from the oven; let stand 5 minutes before serving.

#### Texas Cheese Steak

Olive oil

- I large white onion, sliced I red bell pepper, sliced
- I green bell pepper, sliced
- 2-3 jalaneños, sliced
- Salt, to taste (divided use)

Pepper, to taste (divided use)

- 2 Tbsp. minced garlic 2 lbs. shaved rib eye
- Tbsp. garlic powder, to taste Tbsp. onion powder, to taste
- Tbsp. seasoning salt
- 2 Tbsp. butter
- 3 Tbsp. Worcestershire sauce 5-6 small French bread loves or bolillos 10-12 slices pepper jack cheese
- I. Heat two pans coated with olive oil on medium-high heat. Add the vegetables to one of the pans with salt and pepper. Cook until soft; add minced garlic. Cook until fragrant.
- 2. Add the rib eye to the other pan with salt, pepper and seasoning salt. Once the meat is almost cooked through, add the
- butter and Worcestershire sauce.

  3. While the meat and peppers cook, toast the bread.
- 4. To assemble: Open the bread; add 2 slices of cheese, then the peppers and meat. Add whatever other condiments you like (mustard, mayonnaise, ketchup, etc.).
