Subject: Weekly Update

PUBLIC WORKS

Operational Updates:

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 29.292 million gallons during this reporting period, January 9-January 15, up from 29.12 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.345 million gallons was used on Wednesday, January 11. There were 0.00 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Fifteen hydrants were flushed, and four valves were exercised.
- There was one service leak, and one main line was repaired.
- An estimated 277,496 gallons of water loss occurred.
- Crews responded to twelve sewer backup calls and repaired one sewer lateral.

Street Division

- Marked nine right-of-way locates.
- Responded to a callout request to remove a tree limb from the street on Lady Ln.
- Reshaped a bar ditch on S. Royal Oak Dr.
- Repaired the sidewalk on Willowbrook Dr.
- Set up detours and traffic control for the Duncanville Panthers Championship Parade.

Sanitation Division

• Staff received four trash complaints, and fifteen recycling bins were distributed.

CIP Construction:

E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67) – M-CO, Pavecon's subcontractor, completed the installation of a new Dallas Water Utilities line and is awaiting testing per DWU's schedule. The newly installed 18-inch water line is 99% complete. The peripherals will be completed this week and ready for testing. The contractor is installing drainage infrastructure curb inlets and a creek headwall to prepare for paving.

• The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project – Green Ribbon Project construction is substantially complete. Full completion, including seasonal planting, is scheduled for Spring 2023. The landscape monuments at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Highway 67 are complete. Both monuments are permanently illuminated.



 Fire Station 271 – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022, and monthly progress meetings began on September 7, 2022. Construction has commenced. The contractor is installing grade beams. The Fire Station 271 Groundbreaking Ceremony will be rescheduled, and completion of the station is slated for Fall 2023.



Other Construction

 TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd. – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. Austin Bridge is constructing the Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67.



 ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District – ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced.



FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 129 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - o 93 EMS calls.
 - 11 motor vehicle accidents.
 - 1 brush fire, 1 electrical fire, and 2 trash fires.
 - 2 requests for assistance.
- The Fire Prevention Division completed eleven inspections, four Certificate of Occupancy inspections, attended four pre-development meetings, and conducted seven plan reviews.
- The Department has three vacancies. A Civil Service exam was given on December 17. Sixteen applicants attended the examination, with twelve continuing the process. Applicants' personal history statements will be reviewed before interviews are scheduled.
- Firefighters Tony Jones and Taylor Arrington are attending Paramedic school and performing their ambulance ride-outs.

Building and Inspections

- 1,860 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; no new properties were registered this week. Thirteen inspections were completed since the previous update: eight passed and five failed. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. 1,334 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$385,564.58 has been collected, including \$13,545.31 since January 1, 2022.
- This week 37 permits were issued, and 109 inspections were conducted.
- To date we have inspected 11 mobile vending units.

• Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 110 inspections, including reinspections, and have a total of 45 open cases.

- Expansion at 803, 807, 809, and 811 South Cockrell Hill Road:
 - Replat was approved November 28 at the Planning and Zoning meeting.
 - A zoning change was recommended for approval at the December 12 Planning and Zoning meeting, tabled at the January 3 City Council meeting, and scheduled for Planning and Zoning meeting on February 7 at the City Council meeting.
 - Purpose of replat and zoning is to construct an accessory structure to allow for hearse car parking.
- Ongoing:

• Comprehensive Plan Five-Year Update:

- Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on Opportunity Area 1 and Opportunity Area 8.
- Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.
- Short-Term Rental Registration Program:
 - Six final notices and four initial notices were mailed on August 2.
 - Three properties are going through the Specific Use Permit process.
 - One property is no longer operating as a short-term rental and four properties have registered as long-term rentals.
 - Four property owners have not responded.
 - Five properties were granted a Specific Use Permit by the Council.
 - There are approximately thirteen short-term rentals in Duncanville.


