Subject: Weekly Update

PUBLIC WORKS

Operational Updates:

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 29.12 million gallons during this reporting period, January 2-January 8, down from 31.32 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.013 million gallons occurred on Wednesday, January 4. There were 0.00 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Fourteen hydrants were flushed.
- An estimated 98,000 gallons of water loss occurred.
- Crews responded to five sewer backup calls and televised 215 feet of sewer line.

Street Division

- Repaired nine potholes on Silvercreek Dr. and Meadowglen Dr.
- Responded to a callout request to place barricades around a fallen electric pole on S. Cockrell Hill Rd.
- Responded to a callout request to retrieve a cell phone from a drainage inlet on E. Hwy 76.
- Reshaped ditches on Casa Grande Place and N. Royal Oak to facilitate drainage.
- Repaired the sidewalk on Willowbrook Dr.

Sanitation Division

 Solid Waste staff received five trash complaints and one bulk complaint. Six recycling bins were distributed.

CIP Construction:

• E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67) – M-CO, Pavecon's subcontractor, has completed the installation of a new Dallas Water Utilities line and is awaiting testing. The newly installed 18-inch water line is 99% complete and is at the testing stage. The contractor is installing drainage infrastructure in preparation for paving.

- **FY22 Pipe bursting** Vortex continues pipe bursting activities and is working on Fairmeadows Circle.
- Fire Station 271 Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022, and monthly progress meetings began on September 7, 2022. Construction has commenced. The contractor is installing grade beams. The Fire Station 271 Groundbreaking Ceremony will be rescheduled, and completion of the station is slated for Fall 2023.



 The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project – Green Ribbon Project construction is substantially complete. Full completion, including seasonal planting, is scheduled for Spring 2023. The landscape monuments at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Highway 67 are complete. Both monuments are permanently illuminated.



Other Construction

• TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd. – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. Austin Bridge is constructing the Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67.



• ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District – ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced.



FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 133 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 97 EMS calls.
 - o 3 motor vehicle accidents.
 - 1 building fire.
 - o 6 calls for assistance.
- The Fire Prevention Division completed fifteen inspections, including seven Certificate of Occupancy inspections, and attended four pre-development meetings.
- The Department has three vacancies. A Civil Service exam was given on December 17. Sixteen applicants attended the examination, with twelve continuing the process. Applicants' personal history statements are in review before interviews are scheduled.
- Firefighters Tony Jones and Taylor Arrington are attending Paramedic school and performing their ambulance ride-outs.

- We have nine openings for sworn personnel.
- Training and personnel have exhausted the civil service eligibility list and are working to recruit interested applicants for the upcoming civil service test.

- 142 water disconnections were processed for cycle four customers with a past due balance.
- The utility customer service field crew replaced one meter box lid and two customer meter curb stops in the field last week.

- Staff toured a prospective location with a restaurant developer and met with a Dallas-based developer about potential projects in southern Dallas County.
- The team continues to participate in weekly staff meetings for updates on the Ladd property and the Comprehensive Plan.
- A formal offer has been made for the Economic Development Intern position.

Building and Inspections

- 1,860 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; two new properties were registered since the last update. Twenty-three inspections were completed since the previous update: nine passed, thirteen failed, and one was cancelled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. 1,331 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$385,564.58 has been collected. A total of \$13,545.31 has been collected since January 1, 2022.
- This week 37 permits were issued, and 109 inspections were conducted.
- To date we have inspected 11 mobile vending units.

Neighborhood Services

 Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 76 inspections, including re-inspections, and have thirty-six open cases.

 - A meeting was held on January 9 to discuss comments. A replat will be required.
- o Expansion at 803, 807, 809, and 811 South Cockrell Hill Road:
 - Replat was approved November 28 at the Planning and Zoning meeting.
 - Zoning change is tentatively scheduled for Planning and Zoning meeting on February 7 at the City Council meeting.
 - Purpose of replat and zoning is to construct an accessory structure to allow for hearse car parking.

• Ongoing:

Comprehensive Plan Five-Year Update:

- Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on Opportunity
 Area 1 and Opportunity Area 8.
- Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.

Short-Term Rental Registration Program:

- Six final notices and four initial notices were mailed on August 2.
- Three properties are going through the Specific Use Permit process.
- One property is no longer operating as a short-term rental and four properties have registered as long-term rentals.
- Four property owners have not responded.
- Five properties were granted a Specific Use Permit by the Council.
- There are approximately thirteen short-term rentals in Duncanville.

PARKS AND RECREATION

Parks:

- The horticulture crew continues planting seasonal tulips in various landscape beds.
- The Parks maintenance crew completed tree maintenance at Lions Park, Chris Paris Park, and Lakeside Park.
- The Ladd Property Committee met with Sam Kieschnick, an Urban Wildlife Biologist from the Texas Parks and Wildlife, and several members of the City Council, on January 7 at 609 W. Danieldale Rd., also referred to as the Ladd Property, to discuss future maintenance of the property.
