Subject: Weekly Update

PUBLIC WORKS

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 27.431 million gallons during this reporting period, January 23-29, 2023, down from 29.251 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.17 million gallons occurred on Monday, January 23. There were 1.12 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Thirteen fire hydrants were flushed, one valve was exercised, and one service line was repaired.
- An estimated 120,112 gallons of water loss occurred this week, and there was one water main break.
- Crews responded to six sewer backup calls. 104 feet of sewer line was televised.

Street Division

- Inspected 149 inlets: cleaned nine and removed two cubic yards of debris.
- Inspected 86 headwalls, cleaned twelve headwalls, and removed eight cubic yards of debris.
- Repaired utility cuts on Nature and E. Cherry.
- Patched one pothole on Mercury.
- In response to the winter weather event, crews sanded bridges and intersections on arterials and responded to Police and Fire call outs. Street Division and Equipment Services Division crews worked 24/7 in 12-hour shifts beginning Monday, January 30.

Solid Waste Division

 The Solid Waste Division received one trash complaint and one call regarding scheduling. Eleven recycling bins were distributed. Republic did not collect trash on Tuesday, January 31, but resumed trash collection on February 3 with a delayed start time.

CIP Construction:

• E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67) – M-CO, Pavecon's subcontractor, has completed the installation of a new Dallas Water Utilities (DWU) line and is awaiting testing per DWU's schedule. Work will resume when the weather permits.

- The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project Green Ribbon Project construction is substantially complete. Full completion, including seasonal planting, is scheduled for Spring 2023. The landscape monuments at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Highway 67 are complete. Both monuments are permanently illuminated.




• Fire Station 271 – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction to construct the new Fire Station 271 in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022, and monthly progress meetings started on September 7th. Construction has commenced. The Fire Station 271 Groundbreaking Ceremony is being rescheduled. The contractor is currently constructing the building foundation. However, there was no construction this week due to the freezing weather. Completion of the fire station is slated for Fall 2023



Other Construction

• TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd. – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. The Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67 is under construction.



 ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District – ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 128 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 92 EMS calls.
 - o 2 motor vehicle accidents
 - 1 structure fire
 - 2 requests for assistance.
- The Fire Prevention Division completed eleven inspections, including two Certificate of Occupancy inspections and one day care inspection, attended four pre-development meetings, conducted three plan reviews, and investigated one fire.
- The Department has three vacancies. A Civil Service exam was given on December 17. Sixteen applicants attended the examination, with twelve continuing the process. Applicants' personal history statements have been reviewed, and five interviews were held on Wednesday, January 25. From those interviews, one candidate will proceed in the process while the other four candidates have been discontinued from the process.
- Firefighters Tony Jones and Taylor Arrington have completed paramedic school, are assigned to shift duty, and waiting to receive their examination scores from the National Registry for State certification.
