

# **PUBLIC WORKS**

#### **Utilities Division**

- Water usage was 29.006 million gallons during this reporting period, January 30 -February 5, up from 27.431 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.323 million gallons occurred on Thursday, February 2. There were 0.77 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Crews responded to five sewer backup calls.

#### **Solid Waste Division**

- The Solid Waste Division received two trash complaints and nine calls regarding scheduling. Three recycling bins were distributed.
- Republic Services did not collect trash from Tuesday, January 31, through Thursday, February 2, due to the winter weather event. They resumed trash collection on Friday, February 3, and continued on Saturday, February 4, to catch up.

#### **Street Division**

- Sanded 135 locations during the ice event, covering 109.33 lane miles.
- Removed fallen trees from right-of-way on Nob Hill, Thistle Green, Cedar Hill, Walnut, Taylor, and Eisenhower, totaling twenty-five cubic yards.
- Patched one pothole on Acton and repaired another in the alley behind E. Cherry.
- Responded to three requests to remove brush from the rights-of-way at Hill City, Red Bird, and Dula, totaling seven cubic yards.
- Began clean-up of ice chat.

#### **CIP Construction:**

• E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67) — Work resumed this week with pressure testing of the Dallas Water Utilities water line and bacteriological sampling of water lines one and two. The landscape subcontractor is installing irrigation sleeves.

- **FY22 Pipe bursting** Sanitary Sewer pipe bursting resumed this week on E. Fairmeadows Drive. When completed, the contractor will leave for two weeks and return to start the FY23 pipe bursting in the Forest Hills Addition.
- The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project Green Ribbon Project construction is substantially complete. Full completion, including seasonal planting, is scheduled for Spring 2023. The landscape monuments at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Highway 67 are complete. Both monuments are permanently illuminated.



Fire Station 271 – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction to construct the new Fire Station 271 in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022, and monthly progress meetings started on September 7. Construction has commenced. The Fire Station 271 Groundbreaking Ceremony is being rescheduled. The contractor has poured the slab for the building foundation and is preparing for underground utilities via directional boring. Completion of the fire station is slated for Fall 2023



#### **Other Construction**

 ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District – ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced.



• TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd. – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. The Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67 is under construction.

### **Building and Inspection**

- A total of 1,862 single-family rental properties have been registered to date. Fifteen
  inspections were completed since the previous update; four passed, seven failed,
  and four canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence
  of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A
  total of 1346 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of
  the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$385,823.71 has been collected. \$13,804.44 has been collected since January 1, 2022.
- This week 32 permits were issued, and 95 inspections were conducted. To date, we have inspected 11 mobile vending units.

### **Neighborhood Services**

 Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 91 inspections, including re-inspections, and have 28 open cases.

### **Health Inspections**


# FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 161 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
  - 124 EMS calls.
  - 7 motor vehicle accidents
  - 1 structure fire
  - 5 requests for assistance.
- The Fire Prevention Division completed twelve inspections, including five Certificate of Occupancy inspections. The Division also signed off on two Certificates of Occupancy, attended four pre-development meetings, and conducted two plan reviews and system checks.
- The Department has three vacancies. A Civil Service exam was administered on December 17, 2022. Five interviews were held on Wednesday, January 25. From those interviews, one candidate will proceed in the process while the other four candidates have been discontinued from the process. The Department is waiting on the testing results for one candidate.
