## PARKS AND RECREATION

## **PUBLIC WORKS**

#### **Street Division**

- Removed fallen trees, totaling fifty-one cubic yards, from rights-of-way on Candlelight, Athenia Way, Valleyview, S. Main, Blanco, and Cedar Hill at Danieldale.
- Patched forty-four potholes in various locations throughout the City.
- Repaired utility cuts on Hitchcock.
- Inspected forty-three headwalls, cleaned eighteen, and removed twenty-five cubic yards of trash and debris.
- Marked thirteen right-of-way locates.
- Removed trees from rights-of-way on Azalea and Valley Hill.
- Removed brick pavers from the median on Camp Wisdom as part of the Fire Station 271 construction project.

#### **Utilities Division**

- Water usage was 31.699 million gallons during this reporting period, February 27 through March 5, up from 27.461 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 8.053 million gallons occurred on Friday, March 3. There were 2.31 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Six hydrants were flushed.
- An estimated water loss of 28,000 gallons occurred.
- Crews responded to three sewer backup calls and repaired one sewer service.
- 10,775 ft. of sewer line was cleaned in WD Basin (Green Hills) and La Mexicana.
- Assisted with right-of-way locates.

#### **Solid Waste Division**

 The Solid Waste Division received five calls regarding the solid waste pick-up schedule and two calls regarding trash and bulk collection. Six recycling bins were distributed to residents.

#### **CIP Construction:**

• E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67) – The subgrade is 99% complete. The Dallas Water Utilities water main has been completed. Water line 4 has been completed and is under testing. Lime treatment of the eastbound subgrade started on March 7, 2023. One hundred tons were placed ahead of the forecasted rain. Nighttime paving has been postponed by approximately one week due to weather conditions delaying the lime treatment. The nighttime concrete pour will occur between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. PaveCon will notify affected residents and businesses of the nighttime paving and traffic impact. Concrete placement for the sidewalks and turn lane will occur after the nighttime paving is complete and during regular working hours. To allow sufficient cure time for the concrete, the eastbound lanes of Danieldale Rd. are anticipated to open on April 24, 2023. Dates are approximate and can be delayed due to weather and supply issues.

 The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project – Green Ribbon Project construction is substantially complete. Full completion, including seasonal planting, is scheduled for Spring 2023. The landscape monuments at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Highway 67 are complete. Both monuments are permanently illuminated.



• Fire Station 271 – Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement with CORE Construction to construct the new Fire Station 271 in June 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022, and monthly progress meetings started on September 7. Construction has commenced. The Fire Station 271 Groundbreaking Ceremony is being rescheduled. The steel building was delivered on February 22 and is currently being erected. The fire line and water utilities have been connected to the City's water main. The Streets Division is making improvements to the median. Completion of the fire station is slated for Fall 2023.






Fire Station 271 building being erected.

#### Other Construction

• TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd. – TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. The Texas U-Turn at Cockrell Hill and Highway 67 is under construction.

### **Building and Inspection**

- A total of 1,867 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; one new property was registered since the last update. Thirty-two inspections were completed since the previous update; eighteen passed and thirteen failed. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,364 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$387,146.46 has been collected. \$15,127.19 has been collected since January 1, 2022.
- This week 48 permits were issued, and 107 inspections were conducted.

### **Neighborhood Services**

 Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 115 inspections, including reinspections, and have 42 open cases.

#### **Health Inspections**

 Our Health Inspector conducted fourteen inspections of food establishments, twelve of which were routine. One food establishment inspection was complaint based, and the other was for a Certificate of Occupancy.

## New and Potential Projects:

- New Development at 518 East Highway 67:
  - A preliminary meeting was held on July 12, 2022.
  - Proposed project is currently in the pre-development stage and staff has been meeting with developers occasionally throughout this stage.
- New Development at 750 W. Camp Wisdom Road:
  - Planned development request was approved at the October 18, 2022
     City Council meeting.
  - Plans have been approved by all departments.
  - A permit will be issued once the sub-contractors register.
  - A pre-construction meeting was held on February 15.
- New Development at 704 N. Main Street:
  - The site plan was submitted on August 30, 2022.
  - A building permit application was submitted on November 18, 2022.
  - A meeting was held on January 9, 2023, to discuss further items required for issuing a permit.
  - A replat will be required. A replat application was submitted on February 16, and is scheduled for the April 4 Planning and Zoning meeting.
- New Development at 1203 North Cockrell Hill Road:
  - A pre-development meeting was held on February 6.
  - The civil plan was submitted on February 9 for pre-review prior to submitting the building permit.
  - No zoning will be required for the new building.
- Costco Fuel Expansion at 250 West Highway 67:
  - A pre-development meeting was held on February 7.
  - An updated site plan will be required when submitting the permit application; any new signage will also require permits.
  - Planning will require updated landscaping and photometric plans.
- New multi-family component, phase 2, at 402 W. Wheatland Rd.:
  - Approved by City Council on December 6, 2022, via Ordinance No. 2461.
  - A pre-development meeting was held on February 20.

#### Ongoing:

- Comprehensive Plan Five-Year Update:
  - The Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on Opportunity Area 8, Ladd Property.
  - The first community meeting for the Comprehensive Plan was held on Thursday, March 9. The remaining community meeting dates are:
    - Thursday, March 16, 6:30 p.m. at the Senior Center.
    - Thursday, March 23, 6:30 p.m. via Zoom.

## Short-Term Rental Registration Program:

- Six final notices and four initial notices were mailed on August 2, 2022.
- Three properties are going through the Specific Use Permit process.
- One property is no longer operating as a short-term rental and four properties have registered as long-term rentals.
- Four property owners have not responded.
- Five properties have been granted a Specific Use Permit by the Council since July 2022.

- Recruit Paul Becerra is in the Regional Police Academy.
- Officer Jessica Determan is in Field Training.
- Training and Personnel are conducting background investigations on applicants.
- We have nine openings for sworn personnel.

## FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 139 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
  - o 100 EMS calls
  - 12 motor vehicle accidents
  - 1 structure fire
  - 1 natural vegetation fire
  - 1 grass fire
  - 1 transport vehicle fire
  - 8 requests for assistance
- The Fire Prevention Division completed eighteen inspections and five Certificate
  of Occupancy inspections, attended six pre-development meetings, conducted five
  plan reviews, and performed two system checks.
- The Department has two vacancies. The new candidate started employment on February 27. The candidate will be in orientation and training for four to six weeks before he can be counted as staffing. Unfortunately, one of our valuable firefighter/paramedics has tested for the Plano Fire Department. He is number six on their eligibility list. The Department is working with Human Resources to schedule a new Civil Service Entrance Exam.
- Chief Rohde will be attending the Texas Fire Chiefs Executive Conference March 20-23, 2023, in Waco.




