PUBLIC WORKS

Street Division

- Patched three potholes in various locations.
- Repaired utility cuts on Brookside, Swan Ridge, W. Camp Wisdom Rd., and E. Camp Wisdom.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 29.071 million gallons during this reporting period, April 3-9, up from 28.999 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.686 million gallons occurred on Saturday, April 8. There were 0.29 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Thirteen hydrants were flushed, and five valves were exercised.
- An estimated water loss of 181,176 gallons occurred, including three water main breaks.
- One fire hydrant was repaired.
- Crews responded to four sewer backup calls, cleaned 10,100 feet of sewer line in WD Basin (Greenbriar addition), and televised 110 feet of sewer line.

Sanitation Division

- The Solid Waste Division received six calls regarding the solid waste pick-up schedule and four complaints: one brush, one bulk, and two trash. Ten recycle bins were distributed to residents.

CIP Construction:

- **E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)** – The subgrade is 99% complete. Paving continues with the turn lanes, and median pours are scheduled for April 13 and 14. These concrete pours will be tailgated from the concrete trucks. Bob Lee Blvd., at the Duncanville Service Center, was closed on April 4, for paving improvements. It will be closed for at least 30 days. The Shady Trail entrance from S. Main St. was reopened after utility and pavement improvements. With Bob Lee closed, Shady Trail provides the only access road to the Service Center.

- **The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project** – Green Ribbon Project construction is substantially complete. Full completion, including seasonal planting, is scheduled for April or May. The landscape monuments at Cockrell Hill Rd. and Highway 67, as well as Wintergreen Rd. at Highway 67, are complete. Both monuments are permanently illuminated.



- **Fire Station 271** – The Fire Station 271 Plaque Signing Ceremony will be held in May 2023. CORE will provide the plaque. Staff awaits information on the proposed plaque delivery date before scheduling the ceremony. CORE Construction continues erecting the building and rear perimeter fencing. Completion of the fire station is slated for Fall 2023.

Other Construction

- **TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd.** – TXDOT is constructing new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd in Duncanville to Hampton Rd in Dallas, including new bridges across US-67. This project also includes construction by TXDOT of a Texas U-Turn at US 67 and Cockrell Hill Rd on the southwest side of the bridge. The project has an estimated completion date of January 2025.



DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Economic Development

- Attended a Development Review Committee meeting to discuss retail expansion and related infrastructure for a project along Daniieldale Road.
- Met with a regional developer to discuss redevelopment opportunities in Duncanville.
- Worked on a marketing campaign related to National Small Business Week (NSBW) to celebrate Duncanville small businesses. NSBW is April 30 to May 6, 2023.
- Met with site selector teams for two restaurant concepts.

Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 138 inspections, including re-inspections, and have 54 open cases.

Building and Inspections

- A total of 1,890 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; one new property was registered this week. Twenty-four inspections were completed since the previous update; twelve passed, eleven failed, and one was canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,403 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- This week 42 permits were issued, and 84 inspections were conducted.

- Training for all personnel on the P25 portable radios will be conducted April 17-19. The system is scheduled to go live April 25.

- The Fire Prevention Division completed eleven Certificate of Occupancy inspections, attended seven pre-development meetings, conducted four plan reviews, and performed four system checks.

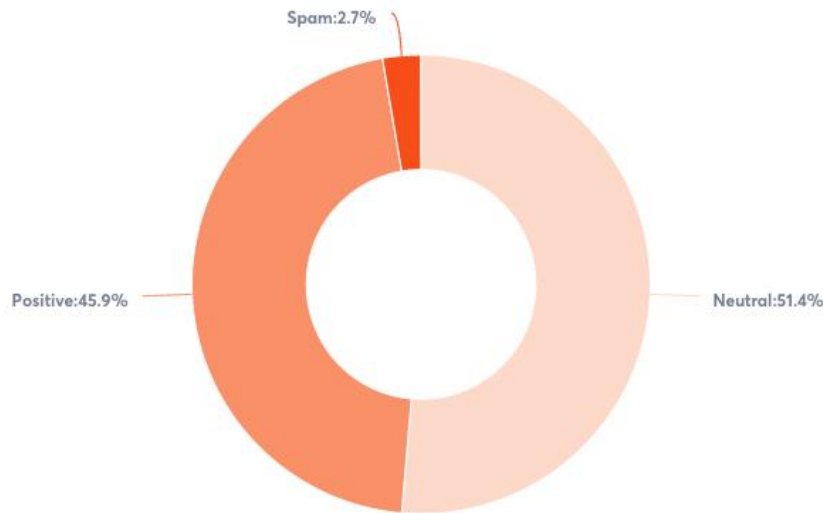
