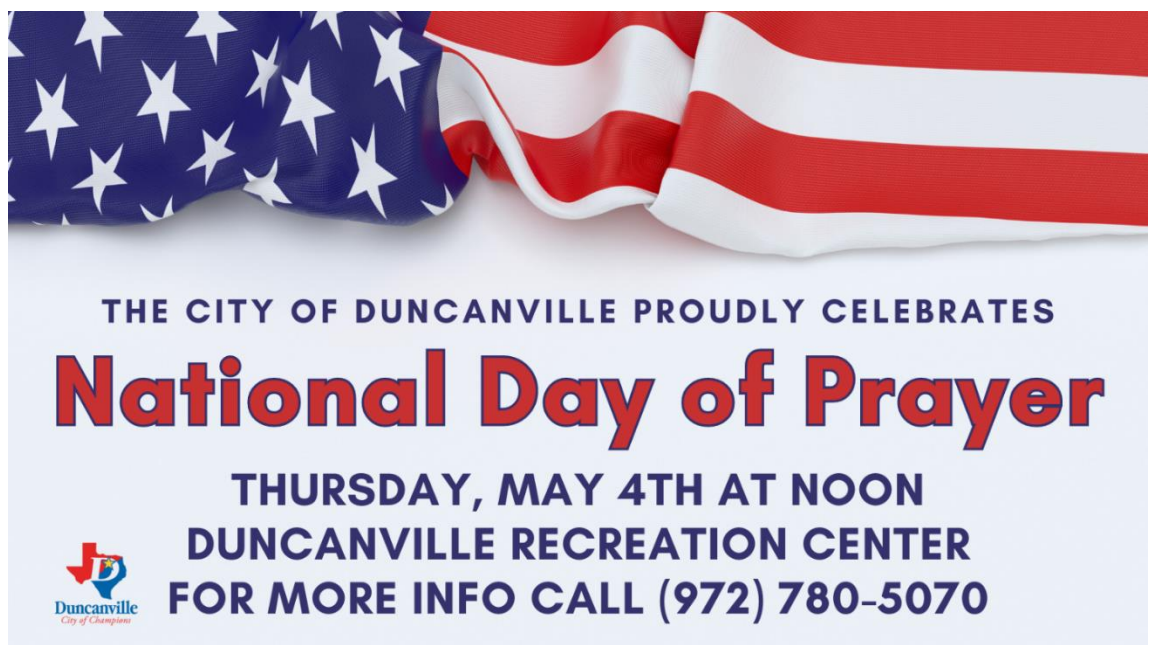

PUBLIC WORKS

Operational Updates:

Street Division

- Completed a concrete drive approach on London to facilitate drainage.
- Installed asphalt tie-ins to driveways on Jungle, Oriole, and W. Davis.
- Marked five utility drainage right-of-way locates.
- Removed fallen tree blocking traffic on Hill City.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 31.387 million gallons during the reporting period of April 17-23, down from 33.013 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 5.173 million gallons occurred on Tuesday, April 18. There were 0.18 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 70,000 gallons occurred.
- Twenty fire hydrants were flushed, and one service line was repaired.
- Crews responded to five sewer backup calls, Cleaned 4,525 ft. of sewer line in the Greenbriar Addition, and 5,625 ft. in Penn Springs and Skyview Estates.

Sanitation Division

- The Solid Waste Division received two calls regarding the solid waste pick-up schedule and six complaints (one trash, one bulk, and four brush). Six recycle bins were distributed to residents.

CIP Construction:

- **E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)** – Paving of driveway sections continues. The first section of Bob Lee was graded and poured. Concrete paving has been removed. Construction was rained out on Wednesday, April 26th, due to inclement weather.



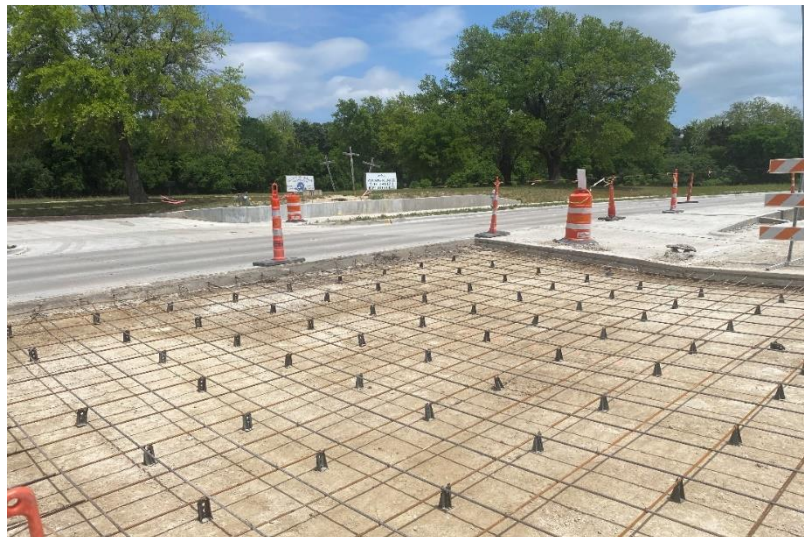

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 133 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 98 EMS calls
 - 2 structure fires
 - 2 vehicle fires
 - 1 dumpster fire
 - 15 motor vehicle accidents
 - 3 requests for assistance
- The Fire Prevention Division completed five routine inspections, five Certificate of Occupancy inspections, attended eleven pre-development meetings, conducted seven plan reviews, performed two system checks, and conducted one fire investigation.
- The Department has three vacancies. The Department is working with HR to schedule a new Civil Service Entrance Exam.
- Training for all personnel on the P25 portable radios was conducted April 17-19. The system went live on April 25 with very few problems.
- Assistant Chief Greg Chase, Battalion Chief Robert Hancock, and Firefighter Paramedic Tristan Spray are attending the Fire Department Instructors Conference (FDIC) International this week. FDIC is one of the leading firefighter conferences. This conference offers thousands of Fire & Rescue professionals from around the world, quality world-class instructors, classrooms, workshops, H.O.T. Evolutions, and the most innovative products and services on display from 800+ exhibiting companies.

- New Fire Station 271 is coming along with the construction of walls.

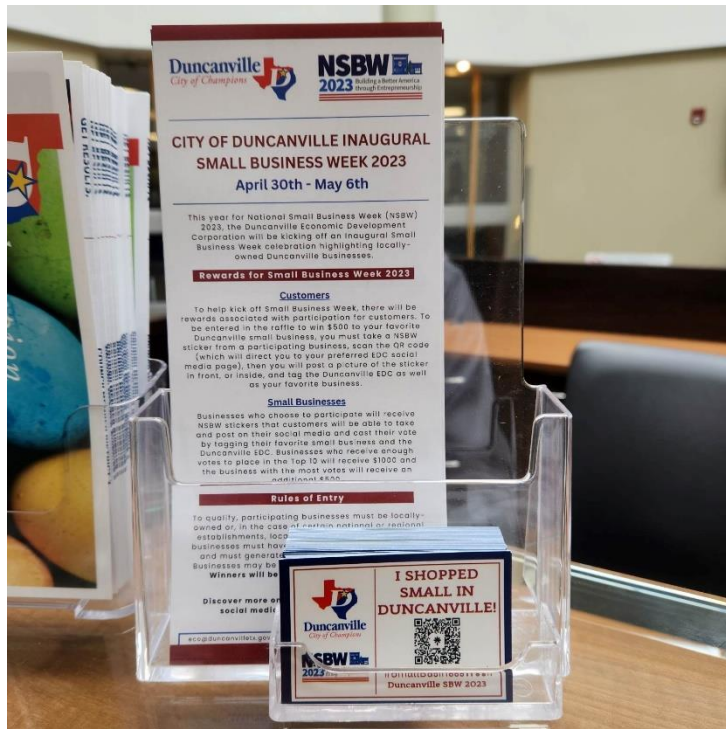




DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Economic Development

- The Tax Increment Financing (TIF) board held a regular meeting on April 24.
 - No action was taken.
- The Duncanville Community and Economic Development Corporation (DCEDC) held a regular meeting on April 24. The following action was taken:
 - Italy Family Pharmacy was approved for a signage grant in the amount of \$6,750.
 - WOW Beauty & Barber was approved in amount of \$23,157 for signage (\$10,000), paint (\$8,500), and landscaping (\$4,657).
 - Jones Inck was approved for a signage grant in the amount of \$6,240.33.
 - City of Duncanville Parks & Recreation was approved for a grant in the amount of \$32,392 for improvements to the Poe-Hobden Ampitheater.
 - Hav-R-Charburger was approved for signage grants in the amount of \$28,000.
- Staff met with the representatives for Project Canard.

Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Services Officers conducted 73 inspections, including re-inspections, and have 27 open cases.

Building and Inspections

- A total of 1,895 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; four new properties were registered this week. Twenty-one inspections were completed since the previous update; eighteen passed, two failed, and one was canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were the absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,420 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- This week 73 permits were issued, and 94 inspections were conducted.

- Our Health Inspector conducted seven routine inspections, one inspection resulting from a complaint, and one site visit.

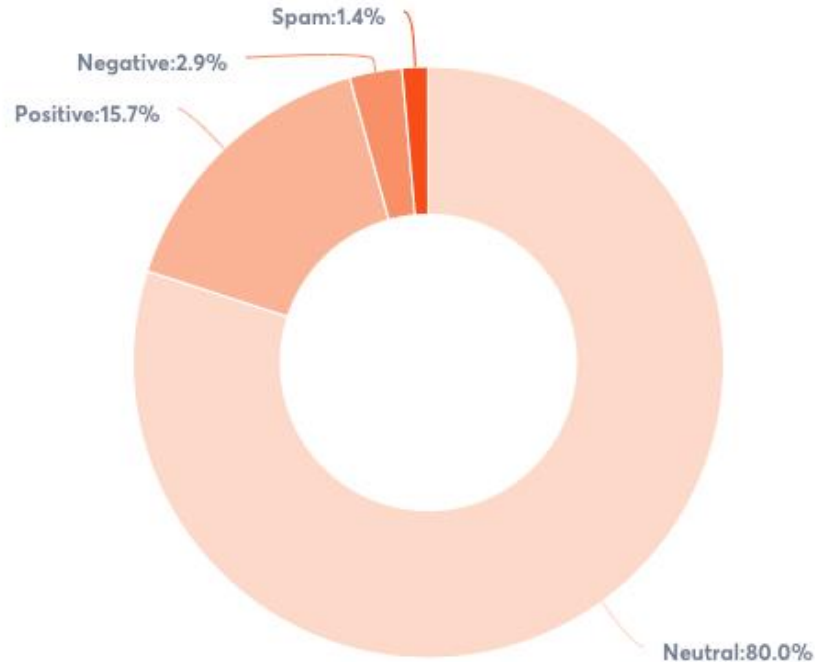
