DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Economic Development

- Staff participated in discussions with developers concerning redevelopment and tenant improvements.
- DCEDC held a special meeting on May 31, 2023.
 - The DCEDC board approved a multi-year grant not to exceed \$434,405 over a three-year period for improvements related to the replating and repaving of parcels under their stewardship, the construction of a new multimillion-dollar commercial structure, and the renovation of pre-existing structure for enhanced commercial sales. Est. capital investment of \$3,246,905 and an additional \$11 million in sales. The Development Agreement will begin to be drafted by DCEDC staff and City Attorney for representation and consideration of approval by the City Council at the June 20th meeting.
- Participated in a meeting with a property manager to discuss the new construction of a commercial space.
- Continued work on the reimbursement of work completed by DCEDC/City Council grant recipients.
- Worked with the Development Services team to discuss new opportunities for collaboration to refine and improve internal processes.

LEGE

- The 88th Legislature adjourned the regular legislative session Sine Die May 29. A special session was called by Governor Greg Abbott to begin May 29 at 9:00 p.m. identifying the following items per the Governor's Office.

Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Services Officers conducted 142 inspections, including re-inspections, and have 67 open cases.

Building and Inspections

- 1,898 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; two new properties have been registered since the last update. Seventeen inspections were completed this week; seven passed and nine failed. 1,443 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program. Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$389,047.23 has been collected. A total of \$17,028.26 has been collected since January 1, 2022, this week we collected \$0.00.
- This week 69 permits were issued, and 67 inspections were conducted.
- To date, sixteen mobile vending units have been inspected, and three mobile vending units were inspected this week.

Health Inspections

- Our Health Inspector conducted thirteen inspections, two routine inspections, two pool routine inspections, five pool re-inspections, three food inspections, one follow-up inspection, one food truck inspection, and two complaints.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 153 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 107 EMS calls
 - 1 building fire
 - 1 trash fire
 - 12 motor vehicle accidents
- The Fire Prevention Division completed seven annual business inspections, four Certificate of Occupancy inspections, and two food truck inspections.
- The Department has four vacancies.
- The Civil Service Entrance Exam is scheduled for June 10, 2023.
- Emergency Management Operations Coordinator, Lauren Sanchez, and Assistant Chief Matt Stogner gave a presentation on the Fieldhouse incident at the Texas Department of Emergency Management Conference in Fort Worth. The presentation covered public safety responses as well as the reunification of the campers with their parents.



PUBLIC WORKS

Street Division

- Repaired sixteen potholes on Silver Creek Dr., Duncanville Rd., Naples Dr., Daniieldale Rd., and Shannon Dr.
- Inspected 116 drainage grate inlets – cleaned 82 and removed four cubic yards of trash and debris.
- Assisted Parks and Recreation with traffic control devices at Armstrong Park in preparation for the Fire Truck Pull event on Monday, May 27, and the Memorial Day Ceremony on May 29.

- Removed fallen tree branch from 303 Memory Ln.
- Repaired concrete sidewalks at 402 Oleander Str., 530 Falling Leaves Dr., and 530 Johnson Dr.
- Removed a drainage inlet absorbent sock from the roadway near the intersection of Clark Rd. and Wheatland Rd.
- Installed tie-in with hot mix asphalt at 709 W. Camp Wisdom Rd.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 32.644 million gallons during this reporting period, May 22-28, up from 30.438 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.875 million gallons occurred on Sunday, May 28. There was 0.32 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 66,500 gallons occurred.
- Nineteen fire hydrants were flushed.
- Six fire hydrants and one service line were repaired.
- One new water service was installed.
- Crews responded to five sewer backup calls.

Sanitation Division

- The Sanitation Division received five calls regarding the solid waste pick-up schedule and seven complaints (four trash, one bulk, one brush, and one neighborhood service). Seven recycle bins were distributed this week.

CIP Construction:

- **E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)**

Grading, forming, and rebar for sidewalks continue. The landscape subcontractor continues to layout and installation of the irrigation system. A soft opening date of June 13, 2023 is presently planned for Danieldale Road- the date will be confirmed next week.

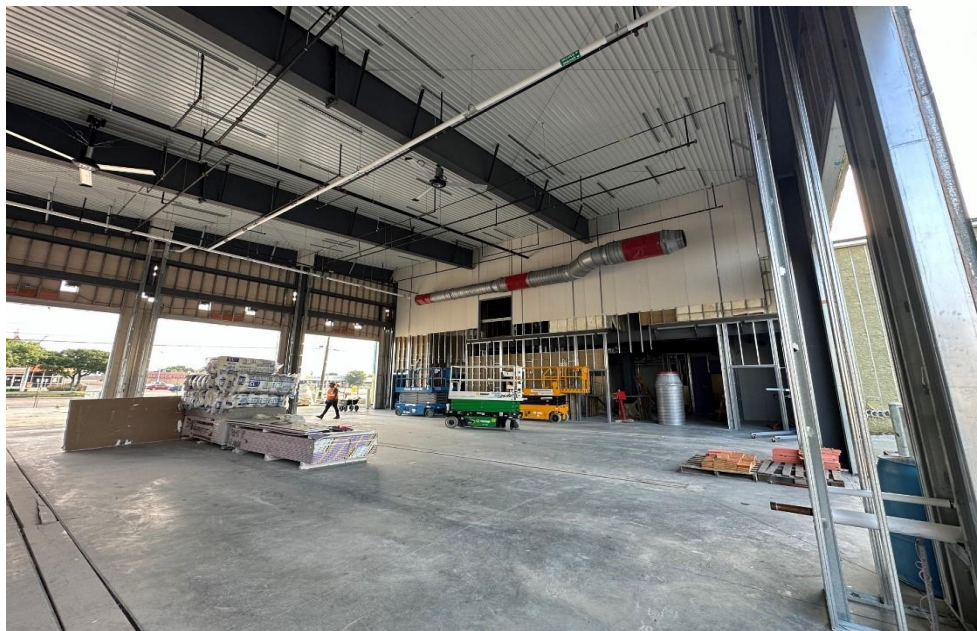
- **The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project** – Green Ribbon Project construction is substantially complete. Full completion, including seasonal planting, is scheduled for June 2023. The landscape monuments, Cockrell Hill Rd. at US 67 and Wintergreen Rd. at US 67, are complete, including full illumination.



- **–Fire Station #1** – CORE Construction’s sub-contractors are working on the building's mechanical, electrical, and drywall aspects. Exterior work is ongoing. The project is approximately 60% to 70 % complete. Completion of the fire station is slated for Fall 2023.

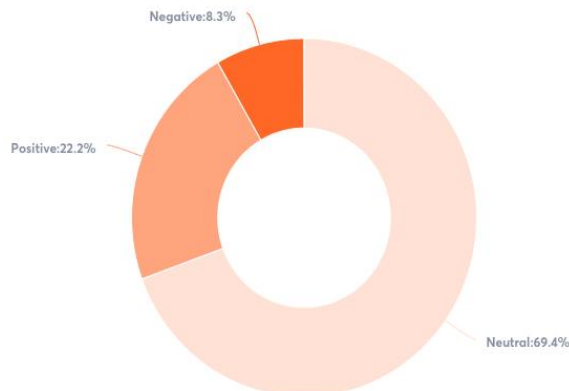
