Economic Development

• Economic Development hosted a tour of opportunities in Duncanville for the Weitzman executive team, including Executive Chairman and founder Herbert Weitzman. This is a direct result of outreach efforts, including attendance at the ICSC annual conference. Weitzman is a real estate firm specializing in retail leasing, tenant representation, management, and development. EDC staff provided the Weitzman team with a personalized tour that explored many different opportunities for investment in Duncanville to revitalize shopping centers. In addition to new opportunities, Weitzman currently operates two shopping centers in Duncanville. The Cedar Park shopping center includes tenants such as TV Fashion Outlet, KFC, Taco Bell, and The Joint

Chiropractic. Weitzman also operates the Shops at Waterview Park, which includes tenants such as Joshua Thibodeaux's State Farm office, Subway, Genghis Grill, LA Fitness, and Frost Bank.

- The DCEDC held a board meeting on June 26, 2023; the following occurred:
 - The board approved the DCEDC budget for Fiscal Year 2023-24 (FY24). The budget will go before the City Council for approval in conjunction with the regular City budget.
 - The board voted to table until July an application by Texas Fadez for improvements to a location they want to purchase. Additional information has been requested.
 - The board voted to approve Creative Beauty Salon Suites for a signage grant of \$5,000.

Neighborhood Services

 Neighborhood Services Officers conducted 203 inspections, including re-inspections, and have 86 open cases.

Building and Inspections

- 1,908 single-family rental properties have been registered; three new properties have been registered since the last update. Twelve inspections were completed this week; seven passed, five failed, and one was canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. 150 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- This week, 49 permits were issued.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 153 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:

- The Fire Prevention Division completed twelve annual business inspections, signed and released one new Certificate of Occupancy, and attended eleven Pre-Development Meetings. Conducted fifteen plan reviews and one system Acceptance/Testing.

 There was a 96% pass rate on the Inspector exams I and II and a 94% pass rate on the Plan Examiner final.

Street Division

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 35.625 million gallons during this reporting period, June 19 June 25, up from 31.738 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 5.668 million gallons occurred on Monday, June 19. There were 0.25.84 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 98,500 gallons occurred.
- Four fire hydrants were flushed, and two valves were exercised.
- Two water services and five fire hydrants were repaired.
- Two new water meters were installed, and one service line was repaired.
- Crews responded to three sewer backup calls and televised 1,200 feet of a sewer line.

Sanitation Division

 The Sanitation Division received three calls regarding the solid waste pick-up schedule and missed pick-ups. Twelve complaints were received about brush collection, as Republic is currently three weeks behind and working to catch up. We have run out of recycling bins and await receiving additional containers from Republic Services.

CIP Construction:

• E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)

Grading, forming, and rebar for sidewalks continue; sidewalks are 90% complete. Road striping has begun, the overpass has been striped and bike lanes have been installed. The landscape subcontractor continues to lay out and install the irrigation system. As of June 28, Eastbound lanes are open for traffic. Medians are still closed for continued landscaping work.
