Utilities Division

- Water usage was 52.666 million gallons during this reporting period, July 24 July 30, up from 48.64 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 7.86 million gallons occurred on Wednesday, July 27. There were 0.00 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 84,000 gallons occurred.
- Ten fire hydrants were flushed this week, and four valves were exercised.
- One fire hydrant was replaced.
- Crews responded to six sewer calls, cleaned 3,100 ft. of sewer line, and televised five sewer lines. Additionally, crews retrieved a resident's keys from a storm drain.

• The Utilities Division received its replacement sewer jet rodder on Wednesday, August 2. The rodder will be used to unstop the sewer lateral and main lines. Additionally, it is used for cleaning sanitary sewer main lines for preventative maintenance.

- Republic Services will be back on schedule with bulk/brush pick-up beginning Monday, August 7.
- Two recycle bins were distributed this week.

CIP Construction:

• E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)

PaveCon reports that all lanes of traffic will be open by August 8. Landscaping continues, and PaveCon works on the punch list and deficiency items. The Rip Rap at Storm B outfall has been replaced and is grouted.

- Swan Ridge Reconstruction and Beaver Creek and Shady Tree Place Waterline Replacement Project
 - A contract for infrastructure improvements was awarded (street and utility infrastructure) for Swan Ridge, Beaver Creek Dr., and Shady Tree PI. segments as a part of the Swan Ridge Reconstruction Project to SYB Construction on May 18. 2023.
 - SYB Construction issued the Notice to Proceed (NTP) in June. They are mobilizing for the project and are expected to begin construction in late summer/early fall.
 - SYB Construction has completed the resident construction notification. Additionally, they have applied for right-of-way permits (utility locates) and are sending submittals for staff review.
