Street Division

- Repaired concrete alley at Heather Wood Dr.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 39.36 million gallons during this reporting period, September 11 –
 September 17, down from 48.537 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak
 water demand of 8.369 million gallons occurred on Wednesday, September 13. There
 was 1.42 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 38,500 gallons occurred.
- Eleven fire hydrants were flushed this week.
- Crews responded to five sewer calls and cleaned 16,225 ft. of sewer line on Woodhaven Blvd., Duncanville Rd. and at the Tortilla Factory.

Sanitation Division

- The Sanitation Division received three calls (one trash, two bulk, and one brush).
- Six recycle bins were distributed this week.


FIRE DEPARTMENT





National Hispanic Heritage Month is a time to recognize the contributions made by Hispanic and Latino Americans. It's a time to celebrate their heritage and culture while recognizing their presence and influence in the United States.

The observation started in 1968 as Hispanic Heritage Week under President Lyndon Johnson and was expanded by President Ronald Reagan in 1988 to cover 30 days starting on September 15 and ending on October 15. It was enacted into law on August 17, 1988, with the approval of Public Law 100-402.

The day of September 15 is significant because it is the anniversary of independence for Latin American countries Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. In addition, Mexico and Chile celebrate their independence days on September 16 and September 18, respectively.






NUMBER OF REQUESTS


