The failed inspections were due to the absence of GFCI protection and missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors.

# **Utilities Division**

- Water usage was 35.458 million gallons during this reporting period, October 9 October 15, down from 37.135 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 5.444 million gallons occurred on Wednesday, October 11. There was 0.00 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 359,653 gallons occurred.
- Thirteen fire hydrants were flushed, nine valves were exercised, one new meter was installed, and one service line was repaired.
- Crews responded to one sewer call this week.

# **Sanitation Division**

- The Sanitation Division received five calls: three trash, one brush, and one bulk.
- Republic Services distributed 22 recycle bins this week.

- Swan Ridge Reconstruction and Beaver Creek and Shady Tree Place Waterline Replacement Project
  - SYB Construction continues to install water and sewer utilities on Swan Ridge.
  - On October 14, SYB placed 210 cubic yards of concrete on the north side of Swan Ridge.
  - On October 17, SYB poured the alley entrance on the north side of Swan Ridge, and finished grading the south side of Swan Ridge.
  - On October 18, SYB installed rebar for the south side of Swan Ridge.
- Fire Station #1
  - Core is working with the City and BRW to install an irrigation system.
  - Flooring is being installed in various areas of the Fire Station.
  - Stucco is being completed around the canopy.

# **CIP Construction:**

• E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)

PaveCon has opened all lanes of traffic; temporary traffic control is set as needed during working hours to perform the remaining work. Medians at E. Danieldale Rd. and Main St. have been poured. The veneer is scheduled to be replaced next. The concrete sidewalks and handicap ramps have been completed, and street striping is 99% complete. A pre-final inspection has been completed and the City is waiting on the engineer to provide comments.


# FIRE DEPARTMENT
