- Staff installed concrete drainage riprap on the embarkment on Rock Spring Ln. to mitigate erosion.

#### **Utilities Division**

- Water usage was 40.364 million gallons during this reporting period, October 31 November 5, up from 38.82 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 7.337 million gallons occurred on Tuesday, October 31. There was 0.54 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 10,500 gallons occurred.

- One service line was repaired, and one new irrigation meter was installed at I-20 & Cedar Ridge Dr.
- Crews responded to four sewer calls.

## **Sanitation Division23x**

- The Sanitation Division did not receive any customer calls this week.
- Republic Services distributed four recycle bins this week.

## Swan Ridge Reconstruction and Beaver Creek and Shady Tree Place Waterline Replacement Project

- o SYB continues to install water and sewer utilities on Swan Ridge.
- SYB has completed the driveway pours.
- o SYB has also completed the tops of the drop inlets and the Cedar Hill Rd. tie-in.

- Oncor has established a date of late November 2023 to complete their work and for our construction to resume.

  - Inspection by the Registered Accessibility Specialist Inspector for ADA requirements was completed; minor corrections are to be made by Pavecon.
  - Paving final punch list items are being identified. Minor corrections are to be made by Pavecon.
  - Landscaping continues. We are working with the contractor to ensure all work is completed.
  - Handrail construction began November 8.

## FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 139 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
  - 108 EMS calls
  - 1 cooking fire
  - 15 motor vehicle accidents
  - 3 requests for assistance

- The Fire Prevention Division completed twenty inspections and attended three Pre-Development meetings.
- The Department has three vacancies. The Department's new employee is participating
  in orientation and training and is not included in staffing currently. The Department is
  working with Human Resources to schedule another Civil Service entrance
  examination.
- On Thursday, November 9, at approximately 7:05 a.m., the Department responded to a
  two-alarm fire at the Wimberly Apartments located at 200 Jellison. Our regional
  partners of Cedar Hill and DeSoto assisted with resources to extinguish the fire. Dallas
  Fire Rescue assisted with mutual aid to fill in at station 272 to provide coverage for the
  City while our units were working the fire. Five families have been displaced by the fire
  due to water, fire, and smoke damage. There were no injuries reported.




