PARKS AND RECREATION

Projects:



Helping Hands

The Neighborhood Service Officers help to identify overhanging tree limbs throughout the City of Duncanville. This provides a helping hand to our Fire Department by allowing them to concentrate on emergencies. Tree limbs must be trimmed to 14 feet above the street or alley. This allows fire trucks to pass through safely without delays. Tree limbs must be trimmed 7 feet above the sidewalk to prevent pedestrians from being injured.





Building and Inspections

- 1,935 single-family rental properties have been registered; one new property has been registered since the last update. Nine inspections were completed this week; five passed, and four failed. The failed inspections were due to the absence of GFCI protection and missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors.
- 185 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.

PUBLIC WORKS

Street Division

- Crews repaired utility cuts in concrete on Cherry St. and Power Dr.
- Repaired broken concrete pavement on Stanwyck St.
- Crews marked one utility drainage locate.
- Removed a fallen tree from the fence line at Shady Trl.
- Repaired three potholes on Cockrell Hill Rd.
- Checked 93 and cleaned 71 drainage grate inlets at various locations throughout the City.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 36.311 million gallons during this reporting period, November 20 November 26, down from 48.548 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 5.875 million gallons occurred on Saturday, November 25. There was 0.27 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 249,102 gallons occurred.
- Sixteen fire hydrants were flushed, and two valves were exercised.
- Two fire hydrants were repaired.
- 77 feet of sewer lines were televised.

Sanitation Division

- The Sanitation Division received five calls this week (four scheduling and one trash) for Solid Waste collection services.
- Republic Services distributed four recycle bins this week.

Swan Ridge Reconstruction and Beaver Creek and Shady Tree Place Waterline Replacement Project

- The contractor has completed 995 of the sidewalks.
- SYB replaced the sod on both sides of Swan Ridge and prepping for final inspection.

Fire Station #1

- o Core's landscape subcontractor has completed the planting and irrigation.
- Core is working to complete the interior finish.
- Generator start-up is 95% complete, and we are awaiting test reports from Cummis.

• Cherry Alley Phase 1

 The project will reconstruct approximately 1,200 linear feet of alley pavement and needed drainage improvements between Cherry St. and Center St., from Alexander Ave. to N. Cockrell Hill Rd. Oncor has established a date of late December 2023 for construction to resume.

CIP Construction:

- E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67)
 - Landscaping continues. We are working with the contractor to ensure all work is completed.
 - o The handrail at 102 E. Danieldale Rd. has been installed.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 136 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 94 EMS calls
 - 3 building fires (one in DeSoto and two in Duncanville)
 - 1 passenger vehicle fire
 - 1 cooking fire
 - 5 motor vehicle accidents
 - 6 requests for assistance
- The Fire Prevention Division completed sixteen inspections, conducted fourteen plan reviews, and attended three Pre-Development meetings.
 - Inspected food trucks; two passed.
 - One Apartment Fire cause: "accidental" (believed to be electrical due to "poor connection" (loose wire); the scene was released to property management the same day.
- Firefighter EMT Mason Quin is attending Paramedic School.
- The Department has three vacancies. The Department is working with HR to schedule another Civil Service entrance examination for December 9.

Fire Marshal misc.:

Oversaw Fire/Emergency Drill at the Duncanville Senior Center.

Deputy Fire Marshal:

Inspector II State Test scheduled for December 7.

The A-Shift had a one-alarm Structure Fire at 944 & 946 Wyndham Dr. Most of the damage was to the rear wall connecting 944 and 946. There was moderate water damage inside both structures. Oncor was called out due to Electric meters being removed. The property manager

contacted the Red Cross for tenants. There were no reports of injuries to the occupants or firefighters.


