### POLICE DEPARTMENT

- Quail Run Park:
  - The trail installation is 90% complete.

- The Kidsville pumphouse and playground foundation work has been completed. 50% of the playground structures have been installed, and the swings and climbing structures should be completed this week.






#### Parks:

#### **Building and Inspections**

- 1,937 single-family rental properties have been registered; one new property has been registered since the last update. Seven inspections were completed this week; four passed, two failed, and one was canceled. The failed inspections were due to the absence of GFCI protection and missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors.
- 189 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.

## **PUBLIC WORKS**

#### **Street Division**

 Reshaped drainage ditches and flushed out culverts at drive approaches on Roundtop Blvd.

- Removed a section of street asphalt pavement 10 feet wide and replaced the pavement to enable drainage to flow towards an inlet within the 500 block of Jellison Blvd.
- Crews repaired 8 potholes: three on Joe Wilson Rd. and five on Duncanville Rd.
- Marked drainage utilities at six locations.
- Installed concrete vehicle wheel stops at the Police Department parking lot and on E. Wheatland Rd.
- Replaced two missing manhole covers at 323 W. Camp Wisdom Rd.
- Crews repaired the damaged type III barricade on Joe Wilson Rd. and Santa Fe Trl.
- Installed ADA concrete ramp with sidewalks on Walnut St.

#### **Utilities Division**

- Water usage was 34.272 million gallons during this reporting period, December 4 –
  December 10, down from 37.697 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak
  water demand of 5.318 million gallons occurred on Saturday, December 9. There was
  0.00 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 706,524 gallons occurred.
- Twelve fire hydrants were flushed, and four valves were exercised.
- Crews responded to two sewer calls.
- 9,450 feet of sewer lines were cleaned, and two sewer digs were completed.

#### **Sanitation Division**

- The Sanitation Division received seven calls this week (one scheduling, three backflow questions, one trash, one brush, and one code enforcement) for Solid Waste collection services.
- The Service Center distributed eight recycle bins this week.

#### Swan Ridge Reconstruction and Beaver Creek and Shady Tree Place Waterline Replacement Project

- The contractor has completed Swan Ridge Dr. and is ready for a final inspection.
- SYB has completed 90% of the trench restoration at Beaver Creek and Shady Tree Place.

#### Fire Station #1

- Core's landscape irrigation has passed inspection. The City will conduct a final planting inspection.
- Core is working to complete the interior finish.
- o IT is wrapping up the audio-visual and communications equipment installations.
- Generator start-up and testing are delayed; the contractor's electrician is slated to install the missing wire between the generator and the automatic transfer switch (ATS).
- Staff are making provisions for perimeter fencing.

#### Cherry Alley Phase 1

- The project will reconstruct approximately 1,200 linear feet of alley pavement and needed drainage improvements between Cherry St. and Center St., from Alexander Ave. to N. Cockrell Hill Rd.
- Oncor has established a revised completion date of December 13, 2023, to finish the relocation of their power lines. Construction was slowed due to the rocky soil and underground utilities.
- Alley construction will resume in January 2024.

#### • E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction & Utility Improvements Project

- o The subcontractor is working on the remaining items on the landscape punch list.
- The project is substantially complete; staff is working with the contractor to complete all remaining items.

## **LIBRARY**

The Library received a substantial food donation for its Little Free Pantry! This was made possible through donations collected during the Duncanville Arts Commission's inaugural Arts Mixer on December 7. We are very grateful to the Arts Commission and all the attendees of the beautiful event!





### FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 140 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
  - 95 EMS calls
  - 2 Structure fires (one in Cedar Hill, one in DeSoto, and one in Duncanville)
  - 1 cooking fire in Duncanville
  - 1 vehicle fire in Duncanville
  - 2 grass fires in Duncanville
  - 12 motor vehicle accidents
  - 6 requests for assistance
- The Fire Prevention Division completed twelve inspections, conducted nine plan reviews, two Suppression System Acceptance/Testing inspections, and attended six Pre-Development meetings.
- Firefighter EMT Mason Quin is attending Paramedic School.
- The Department has two vacancies. The department conducted a civil service entrance examination on December 9, and 24 applicants signed up. Eleven candidates participated in the exam. Four candidates are not qualified; the remaining seven will submit a Personal History Statement for evaluation.
- Assistant Chief Chase and Firefighter Micah Shaw traveled to Ohio to complete a final inspection of the new ambulance. The estimated delivery is scheduled for next week.

- The Police and Fire Departments are actively processing candidates to fill vacancies within their Civil Service entry-level positions. The Police Department administered an

entry examination on September 23; there are eighteen candidates on the eligibility list. The Fire Department administered an entry examination on December 9; eleven candidates are on the Eligibility List.

The City onboarded one new employee in this pay period.



December Employee Spotlight

Arthur Rodgers, Neighborhood Service Officer

I am a Neighborhood Service Officer - most do not understand that title until the words "Code Enforcement" are mentioned. My primary duty is to establish a rapport with Duncanville citizens by listening, educating, enforcing, and maintaining city ordinances while providing quality customer service. During my time here, I have worked in Litter Control, at the Rec Center, and currently in Neighborhood Services. My favorite part of my present role is gaining compliance because there is a feeling of accomplishment in making the City of Duncanville safe and clean. The major highlight in my career is working with the other Neighborhood Service Officers, Director, and Executive Assistant; they are the true dream team! The City's Neighborhood Service Officers have almost 100 years of Code Enforcement experience, knowledge, skill set, and professionalism. Who would not be proud of their city being represented by such hard-working individuals? A recent accomplishment was abating a property in the city that had become an eye sore to the neighborhood caused by several code violations. The NSOs and I were able to give relief to the community by removing the trash and debris and filling two 30-yard dumpsters in the process. Several citizens of the area drove by and approached us to say, "thank you." Most people do not know I am a Military Veteran that served in the United States Army for eight years. I was also formerly employed with the City of Dallas as a Code Enforcement Officer for 23 years.


