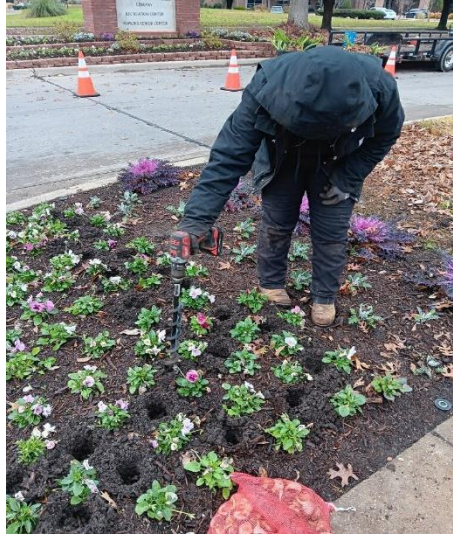
- Daddy Daughter Dance – Saturday, February 17, 2024 | 6:00 P.M.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

COMMUNITY CORNER

- Members of the Duncanville Police Department and the Duncanville ISD Police Department attended a choir performance by the students at the Merrifield Elementary School.
- Officers David Rawlins and Trevin Green conducted eleven VIN Inspections.
- Detectives David Moon and Kyle Welling assisted the Dallas Auto Theft Unit in executing a search warrant at a Dallas-based scrap yard. The search results from the multi-agency investigation began in October 2023 with the investigation of the theft of stranded motor vehicles from highways in Duncanville. It was determined that tow trucks were stealing vehicles from locations throughout the DFW Metroplex and delivering them to a location in Dallas where they were being dismantled and crushed. Agencies participating in the search were the Dallas Police Department, Dallas Marshal’s Office, Dallas City Attorney’s Office, Dallas Code Enforcement, Texas DPS Auto Theft, Irving Police Department, and Mesquite Police Department. Multiple persons at the search were arrested, and numerous stolen vehicles, vehicle parts, heavy equipment, and items of evidence were seized.

Building and Inspections

- 1,921 single-family rental properties have been registered; two new properties have been registered since the last update. Nine inspections were completed this week; seven passed, and two failed. The failed inspections were due to the absence of GFCI protection and missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors.
- 205 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 130 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 95 EMS calls
 - 3 Building fires

- 13 motor vehicle accidents
- 9 requests for assistance
- The Fire Prevention Division completed fifteen inspections and attended six Pre-Development Meetings, one plan reviewed, and one Knox Box/Lock Approval.

Investigations:

- Residential Fire in DeSoto – cause “Undetermined”
- Residential Fire in Duncanville – case “Incendiary” (Arson).
- The Department has three vacancies. The interview committee has scheduled interviews with the remaining candidates on the Civil Service list for January 17 and 26, 2024.
- The Department has one firefighter, EMT Mason Quinn, who is attending Paramedic School.

Chief Rohde attended the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) Leadership Development Symposium January 7-10. The Symposium helps in acquiring fresh and up-to-date leadership training. Topics include leadership, management, safety, budgeting, and more. The symposium is free for Texas Emergency Response personnel.

PUBLIC WORKS

Street Division

- Crews conducted utility cut concrete repairs on N. Main St. and Greenway Cir.
- Repaired thirteen potholes at various locations throughout the City.
- Crews removed fallen trees from right-of-ways on Orange St., Hill City Dr., Santa Fe Trail, and Horne St.
- Marked six utility drainage locates on W. Danieldale Rd., W. Camp Wisdom Rd., and Rita Ln.
- Crews cleaned transmission oil spill on Wesley Ln.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 31.3324 million gallons during this reporting period, January 1 – January 7, down from 32.6848 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 4.2314 million gallons occurred on Saturday, January 6. There was 0.05 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 49,000 gallons occurred.
- Fourteen fire hydrants were flushed.
- One new meter was installed, and one service line was repaired.
- Crews responded to eight sewer calls and cleaned 1,300 feet of sewer line.

Sanitation Division

- The Sanitation Division received thirteen calls this week (two scheduling, eight trash, two backflow, and one brush).

CIP Construction

- **Cherry Alley Phase 1**

- Oncor has completed its improvement, and alley construction will resume this month.
- **Swan Ridge Reconstruction and Beaver Creek and Shady Tree Place Waterline Replacement Project**
 - SYB is scheduled to return this week to complete the final water tie-ins and services at Beaver Creek and Shady Tree PI.
- **Fire Station 271**
 - CORE's landscape irrigation has passed inspection. The City will conduct a final planting inspection.
 - CORE is working to complete the interior finish.
 - IT is wrapping up the audio-visual and communications equipment installations.
 - Staff is making provisions for perimeter fencing.
- **East Daniieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project**
 - The project is substantially complete; staff is working with the contractor to complete all remaining items, including the monument lettering.

Other Construction

- **TxDOT I20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd.** TXDOT is constructing new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas,

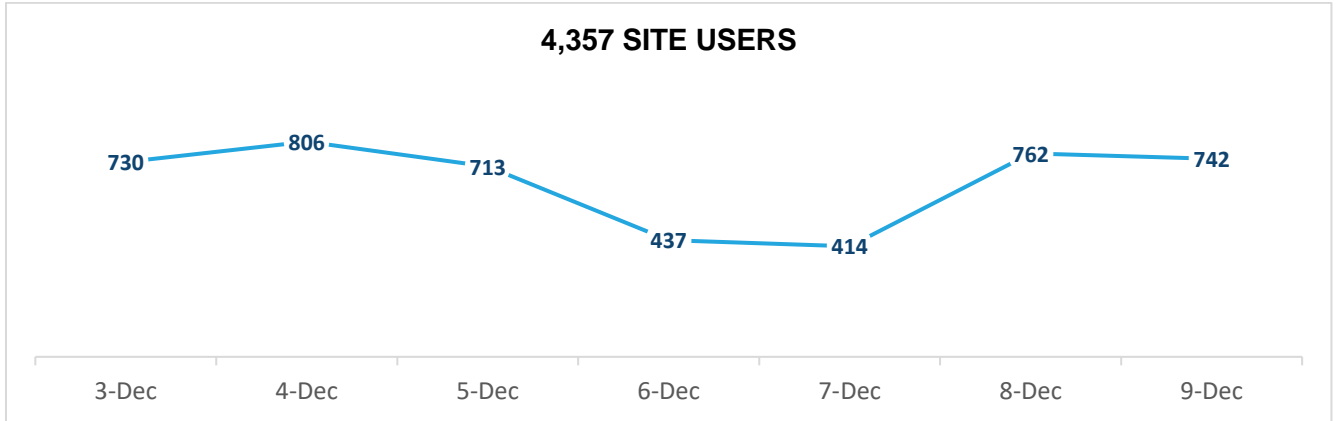


including new bridges across US-67. This project also includes construction by TXDOT of a Texas U-Turn at US 67 and Cockrell Hill Rd. on the southwest side of the bridge, which is projected to be completed by 2024, barring any unforeseen conditions. The entire project has an estimated completion date of September 2025.

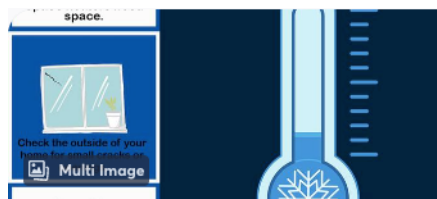
