Economic Development

- The Economic Department welcomed its new EDC Administrator on January 22.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 132 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 85 EMS calls
 - 3 building fires
 - 1 cooking fire
 - 13 motor vehicle accidents
 - 6 requests for assistance

PUBLIC WORKS

Street Division

- Crews removed and cleaned four drainage baskets at Clark Rd. and Danieldale Rd.
- Staff repaired a pothole at the corner of I-20 and Oriole Blvd.
- Restored drainage at the intersection of Action Ave. and E. Magnolia Ln.
- Staff repaired asphalt paving at 251 W. Orange St.
- Staff delivered cones and barricades to Duncanville High School for the upcoming parade.
- Cleaned blocked drainage on Woodhaven Blvd.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 41.444 million gallons during this reporting period, January 15 –
 January 21, up from 31.908 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water
 demand of 7.924 million gallons occurred on Thursday, January 18. There was 0.0
 inches of precipitation during this period.
- An estimated water loss of 550,422 gallons occurred.
- Two fire hydrants were flushed, and nineteen valves were exercised.
- Crews responded to four sewer calls.
- Crews worked 24 hours in 12-hour increment shifts during the winter storm, beginning Sunday, January 14, 7:00 p.m. to Wednesday, January 17, 7:00 p.m.

Sanitation Division

- The Sanitation Division received fifteen calls this week (nine citizen concerns, six trash, two bulk, and one call center).
- Ten recycle bins were distributed to residents.



 TxDOT I20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd. to Hampton Rd. This project also includes construction by TXDOT of a Texas U-Turn at US 67 and Cockrell Hill Rd. on the southwest side of the bridge, which is projected to be completed by 2024, barring any unforeseen conditions. The entire project has an estimated completion date of September 2025.




