Subject: Weekly Update

PUBLIC WORKS

Operational Updates:

Street Division

- Marked 8 right-of-way locates.
- Patched forty-three potholes in various locations throughout the City.
- Removed forty-five cubic yards of brush in right-of way on Oriole and Woodacre.
- Repaired street on and a utility cut on Trail Ridge.
- Removed debris from the street on Springwood.
- Provided traffic control for Duncan-Switch.
- Responded to a tree down request on Royal.
- Arbor-Masters removed a fallen tree blocking the creek's flow behind Woodacre Cir.
- Nortex resumed pavement lifting on Cockrell Hill at Madrid going southbound.
 Eighty-seven percent of the project has been completed.
- Cam-Crete opened all traffic lanes on South Cockrell Hill on September 19. They
 will begin removing the last section of pavement at Apple Corrugated today. Curb
 and gutter replacement should be completed this week.
- Curtco began joint sealing on the 300-500 Block of W. Wheatland Rd.

Utilities Division

- Water usage was 39.109 million gallons this reporting period, September 12-18, 2022, up from 32.88 million gallons the previous week. The daily peak water demand of 6.687 million gallons occurred on Thursday, September 15. There were 0.0 inches of precipitation during this reporting period.
- Thirteen hydrants were flushed, and eight valves were exercised. Three water main breaks occurred; all crews assisted in repairing the breaks.
- An estimated 976,637 gallons of water loss occurred.
- Crews responded to five sewer calls and one sewer dig.
- The Solid Waste Division received seven scheduling questions and ten complaints: two trash, six brush, and two recycle. Seven recycle bins were distributed.
- Annual tank cleaning for FY22 was completed at Clark Elevated, River Oaks Elevated, and North Main Elevated storage tanks.
- The FY22 Sanitary Sewer Evaluation Study began on August 15 and is still underway.

CIP Construction

• E. Danieldale Rd. Reconstruction and Utility Improvements Project (Main St. to US-67) – Pavecon's subcontractor, M-CO, continued installing the 16-inch water main.

 Forest Hills Ramps Reconstruction – The City of Duncanville and the Dallas County Planning & Development Department, via the federally funded HUD Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, are funding construction improvements to the reinforced concrete ramps and sidewalks at four intersections within the Forest Hills Subdivision. Northstar Construction is working on the punch list items now. The push button mounting brackets are expected to arrive next week. Assembly should commence shortly after. The Highway 67 Green Ribbon Construction Project – Green Ribbon Project construction commenced on October 11, 2021, with estimated completion now scheduled to occur in November 2022. In addition to site and irrigation improvements, the contractor is installing piers for the Wintergreen Road monument and pouring concrete for the footings. Landscape planting began in September.



• Fire Station #1 – Staff and BRW Architects completed the 100% Construction Drawings. CORE Construction, the Construction Manager at Risk, put the project out for bid. A "Subcontractor Outreach Event" was conducted on March 22, 2022, at the Senior Center from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., and a Virtual Pre-bid meeting was held on March 24, 2022. CORE opened bids on April 7, 2022. Council approved the Guaranteed Maximum Price agreement in June 2022. Notice of Intent to Award Contract was provided to Core Construction on July 20, 2022. The Construction Kickoff meeting was held on August 10, 2022. Construction commencement should occur in October 2022, and a ribbon cutting is tentatively scheduled for October 25 at 10:00 a.m. The anticipated completion date is Fall 2023.

Other Construction

- ONCOR Transmission Line Work at W. Camp Wisdom Rd. and N. Cedar Ridge – Much of the work to replace transmission lines along Camp Wisdom Rd. has been completed by Oncor's contractor. The contractor removed the tower foundations and is working on sidewalk repairs.
- ONCOR Line Work in the vicinity of the Downtown District ONCOR is upgrading the electrical line along Daniel St., Main St., Center St., Freeman St., and Wheatland Rd. The upgrades will improve the electrical system's capacity in that area. Work has commenced.
- TXDOT I-20 Construction Cockrell Hill Rd to Hampton Rd TXDOT plans to construct new service roads and ramps from Cockrell Hill Rd. in Duncanville to Hampton Rd. in Dallas to include new bridges across US-67. Following City Council Resolution in August, TXDOT will construct the US-67 Cockrell Hill Rd. Texas U-Turn on the southwest side of the bridge. The project was awarded at the beginning of December 2021. The Pre-construction Meeting with TXDOT and the contractor was held on February 1, 2022. Austin Bridge & Road, the contractor, started construction in April 2022, with an estimated completion date of January 2025. A meeting with the Mayor, staff, and TXDOT took place on Monday, August 22, to discuss construction improvements that could impair visibility at the Cityowned property located at 730 E. Interstate Highway 20. TXDOT provided plans and additional renderings to the City.



FIRE DEPARTMENT

- The Fire Department responded to 131 calls for service in the past seven days, which included:
 - 83 EMS calls for service
 - 9 Motor Vehicle Accidents
 - 2 building fires (1 in Desoto and 1 in Cedar Hill)
 - 1 vehicle fire
- The Fire Prevention Division completed 27 business inspections and 2 CO inspections.
- Lauren Sanchez, Emergency Management Operations Coordinator, is currently updating the Emergency Management Annexes, which are documents related to the Best Southwest Emergency Management Plans for disaster situations.
- Duncanville Firefighter Association Local 2999 President Reed Churman, Executive Assistant Lacey Freeman, and Assistant Fire Chief Greg Chase, along with Jessica and Asher Kendall, attended the National Fallen Firefighter Memorial in Colorado Springs. Duncanville Fire Engineer Dan Kendall lost his battle with cancer on July 31, 2020 and has been recognized as a Line of Duty death and his name has been added to the Fallen Firefighter Memorial Wall.

DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

Neighborhood Services

- Neighborhood Service Officers conducted 231 inspections (including reinspections) and currently have a total of 94 open cases.
- The Fall PIP Days Event will be held on the following days:
 - Friday, September 23, and Saturday, September 24.
 - o Friday, September 30, and Saturday, October 1.

Building Inspections

- A total of 1,810 single-family rental properties have been registered to date; six new properties were registered since the last update. Thirty-seven inspections were completed since the previous update: twenty-two passed, twelve failed, and three were canceled. The primary reasons for the failed inspections were absence of GFCI protection, as well as missing carbon monoxide and smoke detectors. A total of 1,218 Certificates of Occupancy have been issued since the inception of the Single-Family Rental Registration Program.
- Since the start of active lien collection in 2019, \$381,697.87 has been collected. A total of \$9,678.60 has been collected since January 1, 2022, and this week we collected \$542.06
- This week 91 permits were issued, and 130 inspections were conducted.

 - The client will need to re-submit revisions and apply for a zoning change.

• Ongoing:

Comprehensive Plan Five-Year Update:

- Planning is at the beginning stages of updating the Comprehensive Plan.
- Planning and Zoning Commission is focusing on the Downtown District area, discussing the incorporation of new areas, and considering ways to incorporate green energy.
- Staff recommendations for updates to the Zoning Ordinance will eventually become a part of this process.

Short-Term Rental Registration Program:

- Six final notices were mailed out on August 2.
- Four initial notices were mailed out on August 2.
- Four properties are going through the Specific Use Permit process.
- Since August 2, one property is no longer operating as a shortterm rental and three properties have registered as long-term rentals.
- Six property owners have not responded to the notices sent out on August 2.
- Three properties have been granted a Specific Use Permit by the Council.

- The Utility Customer Service Office received a total of 516 inquiries about the Senior Discount rate.
- On Sept. 20, we processed 139 water disconnections for cycle two customers with a past due balance.
- All cycle three customers will be receiving a bill insert with their regular water statement regarding the water and sewer rate increase, along with information about the senior discount.
- The Utility Customer Service Field crew replaced three customer metered curb stops this week.

- Staff inspected and monitored contractor performance and addressed specification issues on the Highway 67 Green Ribbon project.
- Staff inspected landscape plants being installed at the Wintergreen and Cockrell Hill landscape beds.
- BrightView Landscape Services completed 18 of its 54 required mowing cycles for the week of September 10 September 17, 2022. Staff continues to meet weekly to discuss quality and scheduling performance issues.
- Staff prepared and set up athletic fields for games practices at Harrington, Alexander, and Lions Parks.
- Staff continues to trim and remove trees from various locations due to the recent rainstorms.






